Action required: Submit applications for interested and eligible candidates by completing the online application

form by 31 July 2025

Sir, Madam,

I have the honour to refer to the Singapore-International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Next Generation of Aviation Professionals (NGAP) Scholarship Programme which is sponsored by the Singapore Government, in partnership with ICAO.

Launched in 2024, the NGAP Scholarship Programme provides 30 Scholarships for young aviation professionals aged 35 years or below, who hold middle management positions or have been identified to take on management positions. Under the NGAP Scholarship Programme, scholars will undergo two weeks of training together with four weeks of attachment in an aviation organization based in Singapore. Scholars will also receive mentoring from Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA) Senior Fellows. Scholarships are open to applicants from all regions. To date, 11 Scholarships have been awarded.

I am pleased to announce that 10 Scholarships will be available under the NGAP Scholarship Programme in 2025. Details of the programme, as well as the terms and conditions of the Scholarships can be found in the Attachment. Please refer to the SAA's website for more information (https://caas.gov.sg/saa/fellowships). It is important to note, however, that the content and delivery of this NGAP Scholarship Programme is outside the Organization's purview and hence the responsibility of the Government of Singapore.

Nominating States should complete and endorse the Nomination Form available online before applicants proceed with the online application for the Scholarships under the NGAP Scholarship Programme at https://caas.gov.sg/saa/fellowships.

SINGAPORE – ICAO NEXT GENERATION OF AVIATION PROFESSIONALS' SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Singapore and ICAO established the Next Generation of Aviation Professionals (NGAP) Scholarship Programme in 2024. Sponsored by the Singapore Government and administered by the ICAO, the programme is targeted at young aviation professionals aged 35 or below who are holding middle management positions or have been identified to take on management positions. A total of 30 Scholarships will be made available. To date, 11 Scholarships have been awarded.

Scholars are to complete a six-week programme in Singapore within three years upon accepting the Scholarship:

- a. One-week Aviation Foundation Programme offered by the School of Aviation Management at the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA)
- b. One-week elective course of your choice from either the School of Aviation Management, School of Aviation Safety and Security or School of Air Traffic Services at SAA
- c. Four weeks of attachment at CAAS and / or with an aviation organisation in Singapore
- d. Three mentoring sessions with an SAA Senior Fellow.

For 2025, 10 Scholarships will be available. States should nominate only one applicant to enable more States to benefit from this NGAP Scholarship Programme.

The deadline for applications for this year is 31 July 2025.

Scholarships

Each Scholarship covers course fees at SAA, hotel accommodation, daily allowance and two trips to/from Singapore on economy class.

Who should apply

The Scholarship is open to government officials from all regions working in a civil aviation function who are:

- aged 35 years or below
- have at least 5 years of working experience in civil aviation
- holding a middle management position or identified to take on management positions
- have a Diploma or Degree or its equivalent
- proficient in English

How to apply

Applicants may apply for the Scholarship here.

Documents required

- Nomination form endorsed by your direct reporting officer (Part 1) and the Director-General of Civil Aviation or equivalent (Part 2). Please download a copy of the <u>nomination form</u> here.
- Curriculum vitae

• Essay of 600 words highlighting your motivations for joining the programme, what you hope to achieve from this programme and how would your experience contribute to the development of international civil aviation in your State and beyond.

How do I know I am successful in my application?

Shortlisted applicants will be required to undergo an interview by a panel comprising members of Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore management. Successful applicants will receive an Award Letter via email. Participants will need to confirm acceptance of the award via email.

How do I complete the Scholarship?

Scholars must complete the programme within three years upon accepting the Scholarship.

Upon acceptance of the Scholarship, Scholars would need to coordinate with SAA on the application of courses, attachment in Singapore and mentoring sessions with SAA Senior Fellows. The application deadline for each course is 16 weeks before the course start date. The list of courses at SAA are found at https://www.caas.gov.sg/saa/saa-programmes.

Entry and visa requirements

Please ensure that:

- Your passport has at least six months' validity on the day you plan to leave for Singapore.
- You have a valid entry visa for Singapore and relevant transit visas for your travel, if required. Please also bring a copy of the Award Letter to Singapore to facilitate immigration clearance.
