

PLAN RÉGIONAL DE MISE EN ŒUVRE COMPLÈTE POUR LA SÛRETÉ ET LA FACILITATION EN AFRIQUE (PLAN AFI SECFAL)

TREIZIÈME RÉUNION DU COMITÉ DIRECTEUR DU PLAN AFI SECFAL

Rapport sur l'état d'avancement de la mise en œuvre des décisions et des recommandations de la douzième réunion du Comité directeur, ainsi que des activités et projets du Plan AFI SECFAL approuvés pour la période août 2023 — décembre 2024

(Note présentée par le Secrétariat du Plan AFI SECFAL)

RESUME ANALYTIQUE

La présente note de travail fait le point sur la mise en oeuvre des décisions et des recommandations de la douzième réunion du Comité directeur du Plan régional de mise en oeuvre complet pour la sûreté et la facilitation en Afrique (Plan AFI SECFAL) tenue à Nairobi (Kenya) le 23 août 2023.

Elle contient aussi le rapport sur l'état d'avancement de la mise en oeuvre des activités et des projets du Plan AFI SECFAL approuvés pour la période aôut 2023 - décembre 2024.

1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 1.1 La douzième réunion du Comité directeur du Plan AFI SECFAL s'est tenue le 23 août 2023. Elle a adopté six décisions et une recommandation auxquelles le Secrétariat et d'autres parties prenantes étaient appelés à donner suite.
- 1.2 Les activités d'assistance fournies aux États entre août 2023 et juin 2024 sont fondées sur les tâches nécessaires à la mise en œuvre des projets prioritaires spécifiques aux États approuvés par le Comité directeur. L'élaboration des projets spécifiques aux États a été aussi orientée par l'évaluation et l'analyse des 1 besoins initiés par le Secrétariat du Plan.

2. ANALYSE

2.1 Durant la période août 2023 — juin 2024, plusieurs décisions et recommandations ont été intégralement mises en œuvre et d'autres sont en cours de mise en œuvre. Celles dont la mise en œuvre n'aura pas été achevée d'ici la fin de l'année en cours (décembre 2024) seront intégrées dans les activités et les projets de l'année 2025 qui vont être présentés à la réunion du Comité directeur à travers la note de travail WP04, pour approbation. Les renseignements sur l'état d'avancement de la mise en œuvre sont fournis dans la **Pièce jointe A** à la présente note de travail. Conformément aux prescriptions, le Secrétariat continuera à informer le Comité directeur sur l'état d'avancement de la mise en œuvre lors des réunions statutaires.

- 2.2 Durant la même période, la mise en œuvre du programme de travail approuvé pour 2023-2024 a connu des retards du fait du manque de ressources financières:
 - a) Parmi les 10 projets spécifiques aux États approuvés, trois sont actuellement mis en œuvre aux Comores et en Guinée équatoriale.
 - b) Des missions d'assistance technique à la mise en œuvre des plans de mesures correctives de l'USAP-CMA ont été effectuées au Botswana, au Burundi, en Namibie, et au Rwanda.
 - c) Le taux global d'EI dans la région AFI est passé de 64,31 % en 2022 à 64,59 % en 2023. On enregistre une amélioration cumulative du taux d'EI depuis la conception du Plan en passant de 53,06 % en 2015 à 64,59 % en décembre 2023.
 - d) L'adhésion du répertoire de clés publiques (RCP) de l'OACI est passée de **18 à 19 États**. En coordination avec le Secrétariat de l'OACI, l'Organisation internationale pour les migrations (OIM) et la Direction exécutive du Comité des Nations Unies contre le terrorisme (DECT), des initiatives conjointes sont en train d'être entreprises pour améliorer la mise en œuvre du RPCV et des dossiers passagers (PNR).
 - 2.3 Vu ce qui précède, il est indéniable que si des fonds ne sont pas mis à la disposition du Plan, certaines activités ne seront pas achevées d'ici fin 2024. Par conséquent, l'obtention de financements adéquats est une condition essentielle pour la mise en œuvre du programme de travail 2023-204. L'état d'avancement de la mise en œuvre des activités figure en **Pièce jointe B** à la présente note de travail.
 - 2.4 Afin de compenser ce manque de ressources, certaines activités des projets ont été mises en œuvre avec des fonds ISD/ATB. Il s'agit notamment des projets spécifiques à la RDC, à la Guinée, et certaines des activités des Comores.

3. CONCLUSION

- 3.1 Le secrétariat du Plan AFI SECFAL reste concentré sur l'achèvement de la mise en œuvre des décisions et des recommandations encore en suspens de la dernière réunion du Comité directeur, et du reste des activités du programme de travail 2023-2024, y compris les obstacles persistants ci-après :
 - a) Résolution tardive des préoccupations significatives de sûreté (SSeC) existante set faible taux d'EI dans certains États dus au fait que l'aviation n'est toujours pas une priorité, l'inadéquation du cadre législatif, l'insuffisance des financements au niveau des 2 États et l'absence d'un mécanisme de financement durable du Plan AFI SECFAL afin de soutenir les activités cruciales d'assistance;
 - b) L'inadéquation des infrastructures de l'aviation civile, l'incapacité à se conformer aux SARP de l'OACI, la lenteur des progrès vers les Cibles de Windhoek et du GASeP et la mise en œuvre insuffisante des résolutions pertinentes du Conseil de sécurité de l'ONU;
 - c) Le manque de données en temps réel pour faciliter la prise de décisions et la planification, l'allocation des ressources et la hiérarchisation des activités;
 - d) La non-soutenabilité du financement pour la mise en œuvre des projets spécifiques aux États et d'autres activités du programme de travail ;
 - e) Les menaces nouvelles et émergentes contre l'aviation civile.

4. SUITE À DONNER PAR LE COMITÉ DIRECTEUR

- 4.1 Le Comité directeur est invité à :
 - a) Prendre note des informations fournies dans la présente note de travail concernant, en particulier, la mise en œuvre des recommandations et des décisions (**Pièce jointe A**) et la mise en œuvre du programme de travail 2023-2024 mis en exergue (**Pièce jointe B**) dans la présente note de travail ;
 - b) Poursuivre la sensibilisation pour la mise en place d'un mécanisme de financement durable pour le Plan durant la période de prorogation de l'échéance (2024-2030), et examiner les options pour obtenir un appui financier à long terme.
