#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This Working Paper presents the status of implementation of the Decisions and Recommendations made by the 12<sup>th</sup> Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa (AFI SECFAL Plan) Steering Committee Meeting, held in Nairobi, Kenya on 23 August 2023.

It also presents the Report on the status of implementation of the August 2023 to December 2024 AFI SECFAL Plan Approved Activities and Projects.

### 1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 1.1 The twelfth Meeting of the AFI SECFAL Plan Steering Committee (SC) was held on 23 August 2023. Six Decisions and one Recommendation were made, which required action by the Secretariat and other stakeholders.
- 1.2 Support activities provided to States as from August 2023 up to June 2024 are based on the tasks required to implement the priority State Specific Projects as approved by the SC. The development of the priority state specific projects was also guided by the needs assessment and analysis undertaken by the Plan Secretariat.

#### 2. DISCUSSION

2.1 During the period from August 2023 to June 2024, several of the Decisions and Recommendations have been fully implemented and some have their implementation ongoing. Those which will not be completed by end of the year (December 2024), will be incorporated in the activities and projects for the year 2025 to be presented for approved by the SC Meeting under Working Paper three (WP03). This is for purposes of implementation continuity. Details of implementation status are highlighted in **Attachment A** of this Working Paper. As mandated, the Secretariat will continue to update the SC on the implementation status during statutory meetings.

- 2.2 Over the same period, the implementation of the approved 2023-2024 work programme has been slowed by a lack of financial resources:
  - a) Of the 10 State Specific Projects approved, three of such projects are currently being implemented in Comoros and Equatorial Guinea;
  - b) Technical assistance missions to support the implementation of USAP-CMA Corrective Action Plans were conducted in Botswana, Burundi, Namibia and Rwanda;
  - c) The current AFI overall average EIs has increased from **64.31% in 2022 to 64.59% in 2023.** The cumulative improvement since inception of the Plan is **an increase in EI from 53.06% in 2015 to 64.59%** as at December 2023; and
  - d) The membership to ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD) has increased from **18 to 19 States.** In coordination with ICAO HQ, International Organization for Migration (IOM) and the United Nations Counter Terrorism Executive Directorate (UNCTED), joint efforts are being undertaken to enhance implementation of API and PNR.
- 2.3 In view of the above, it is undeniable that unless funds are availed, some activities will not be completed by end of 2024. Hence, securing adequate funding is a key factor in implementing the 2023-2024 Work Programme. The status of its implementation is in **Attachment B**.
- 2.4 To compensate for this lack of resources, some of the project activities have been implemented with funding from the ISD/ATB. This includes States specific project of DRC, Guinea, and some activities of Comoros.

#### 3. CONCLUSION

- 3.1 The AFI SECFAL Plan secretariat remains focused on completion of the implementation of the yet to be implemented Decisions and Recommendations of the previous Steering Committee meeting, and the remaining activities of the 2023-2024 Work Programme, including but not limited to the following persistent challenges:
  - a) Delayed resolution of existing Significant Security Concerns (SSeCs) and low EI in some States due to lack of prioritization of aviation, inadequate legislative provisions, inadequate funding at State level and lack of a sustainable AFI SECFAL Plan funding mechanism to support the critical assistance activities;
  - b) Inadequate civil aviation infrastructure, inability to comply with ICAO SARPs, slow attainment of Windhoek and GASeP targets and inadequate implementation of the relevant UN Security Council Resolutions;
  - c) Lack of real time data to facilitate decision-making and planning, resources allocation and prioritization of activities;
  - d) Unreliable funding, to implement the State specific projects and other Work Programme activities; and
  - e) New and emerging security threats to civil aviation.

## 4. ACTION BY THE STEERING COMMITTEE

- 4.1 The Steering Committee is invited to:
  - a) Note the information contained in this paper and in particular the implementation of the Recommendations and Decisions (**Attachment A**), and the implementation of the 2023-2024 Work Programme as highlighted (**Attachment B**) to this Working Paper; and
  - b) Continue the advocacy to establish a sustainable funding mechanism for the Plan during the extended period (2024-2030) and explore potential options to secure long-term financial support.
