- Combination of ECAC Member States and regional experts





- 15 national activities delivered in Year 2 of the Project (November 2016 – October 2017)
- 19 additional activities already delivered / confirmed / planned until mid-2018

National Activities – Mentoring (1/2)

- **MANPADS Assessment & Mitigation**
 - Delivered: Uganda, Senegal, Burkina Faso => follow-up missions in 2018
 - Confirmed: Benin (April 2018)
 - Planned: Tanzania (Q1 2018)
 - Proposal made to Egypt
- **Improving the Use of Available Technology**
 - Delivered: Lomé airport (Togo), Yaoundé & Douala airports (Cameroon), Qatar (focus on EDDs)
 - Planned: Beirut airport (Lebanon - Q2 2018), Windhoek (two airports - Namibia - Q2 2018)



National Activities – Mentoring (2/2)

- Distribution of standard test pieces (STP) during national activities
 - 8 STPs distributed



- Screener Certification
 - Planned: Mozambique (Q1 2018)



National Activities – Vulnerability assessments

- **Vulnerability Assessment – Landside security**
 - Delivered: Abuja airport (Nigeria), Ouagadougou airport (Burkina Faso)
 - Planned: Beirut airport (Lebanon - Q1 2018)



National Activities – Cargo Security

- **Cargo Security Audit**
 - Delivered: Dakar airport (Senegal), Beirut airport (Lebanon)
 - Planned: Abidjan airport - new cargo village (Côte d'Ivoire - Q2 2018)
- **Cargo Security Regulations & Procedures**
 - Delivered: São Tomé



National Activities – Training (1/2)

- **Best Practices for National Auditors – Level 1**
 - Delivered: Rep. of the Congo, Togo, Senegal, Mozambique
 - Confirmed: Lebanon (8-12 January 2018), Jordan (28 January - 1 February), Namibia (19-23 February 2018), Democratic Rep. of the Congo (12-16 March 2018)
 - Confirmed: sub-regional activity with Cabo Verde, São Tomé, Mozambique (9-13 April 2018)
 - Planned: Côte d'Ivoire (Q3 2018)

Regional Workshops (1/2)

- Workshops conducted in 2017
 - Risk Management, January 2017, Dakar
 - => 37 experts from 29 Partner States
 - Cargo & Mail Security, April 2017, Maputo
 - => 20 experts from 5 Partner States
 - Vulnerability Assessments, April 2017, Lomé
 - => 20 experts from 10 Partner States



Regional Workshops (2/2)

- **Next two workshops:**
 - Security Culture, Nairobi (Kenya), 17-18 January 2018, jointly organised with AFCAC
 - Security Culture, Casablanca (Morocco), 27-28 February 2018, jointly organised with ACAC
- **Partner States resulting from regional activities:**
 - 28 in Africa
 - 4 in the Arabian Peninsula
 - In addition to 11 States resulting from national activities
