2B. Through **guidance and capacity building**

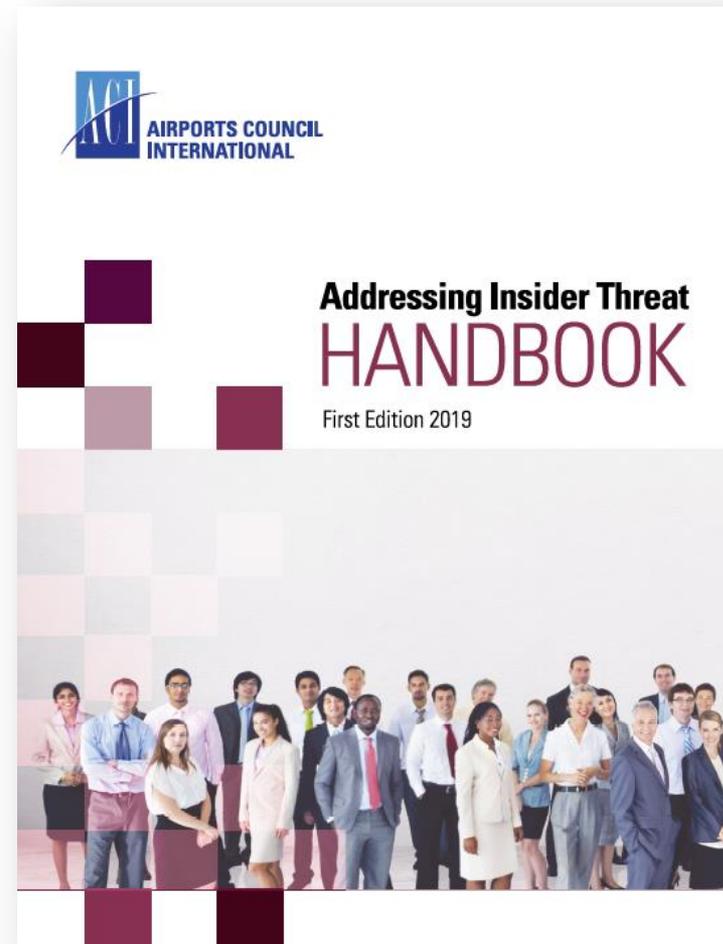
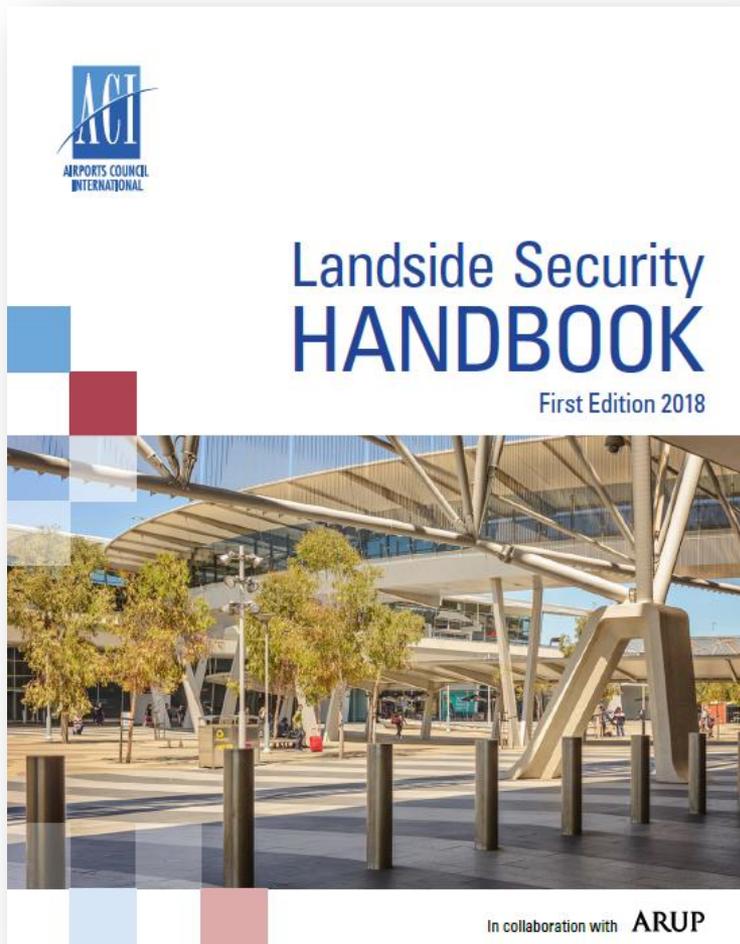

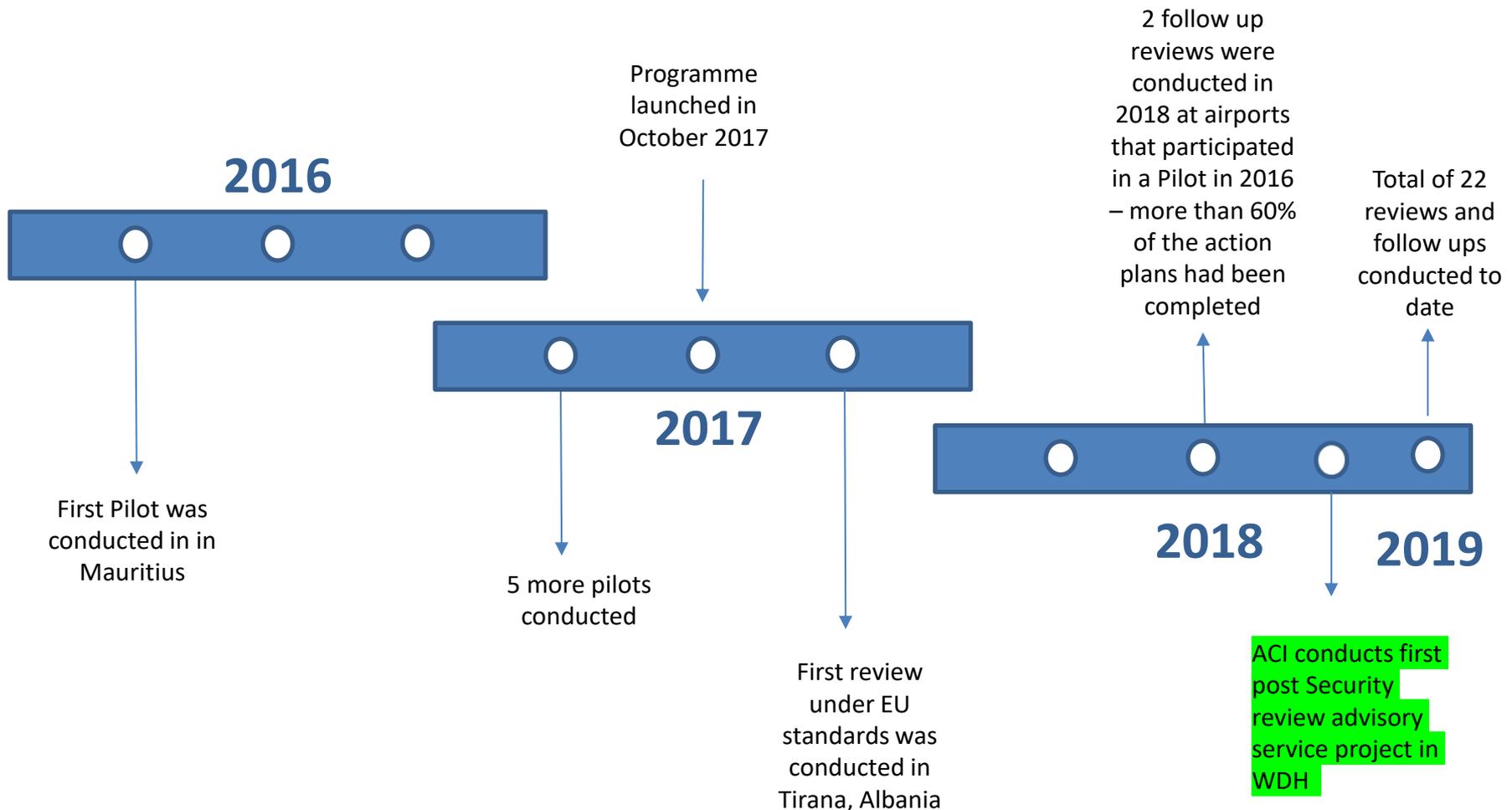
Background to the APEX in Security Programme

- ❑ Peer to peer review with the aim to enhance compliance with ICAO, national regulations and ACI best practices
- ❑ Self-evaluate security performance and implementation
- ❑ Access a network of experts to mitigate any security gaps
- ❑ Receive a comprehensive gap analysis on regulatory and security standards
- ❑ Develop staff and enhance security culture
- ❑ Promote secure airport operations
- ❑ Remains confidential between ACI, ICAO and the Member Airport

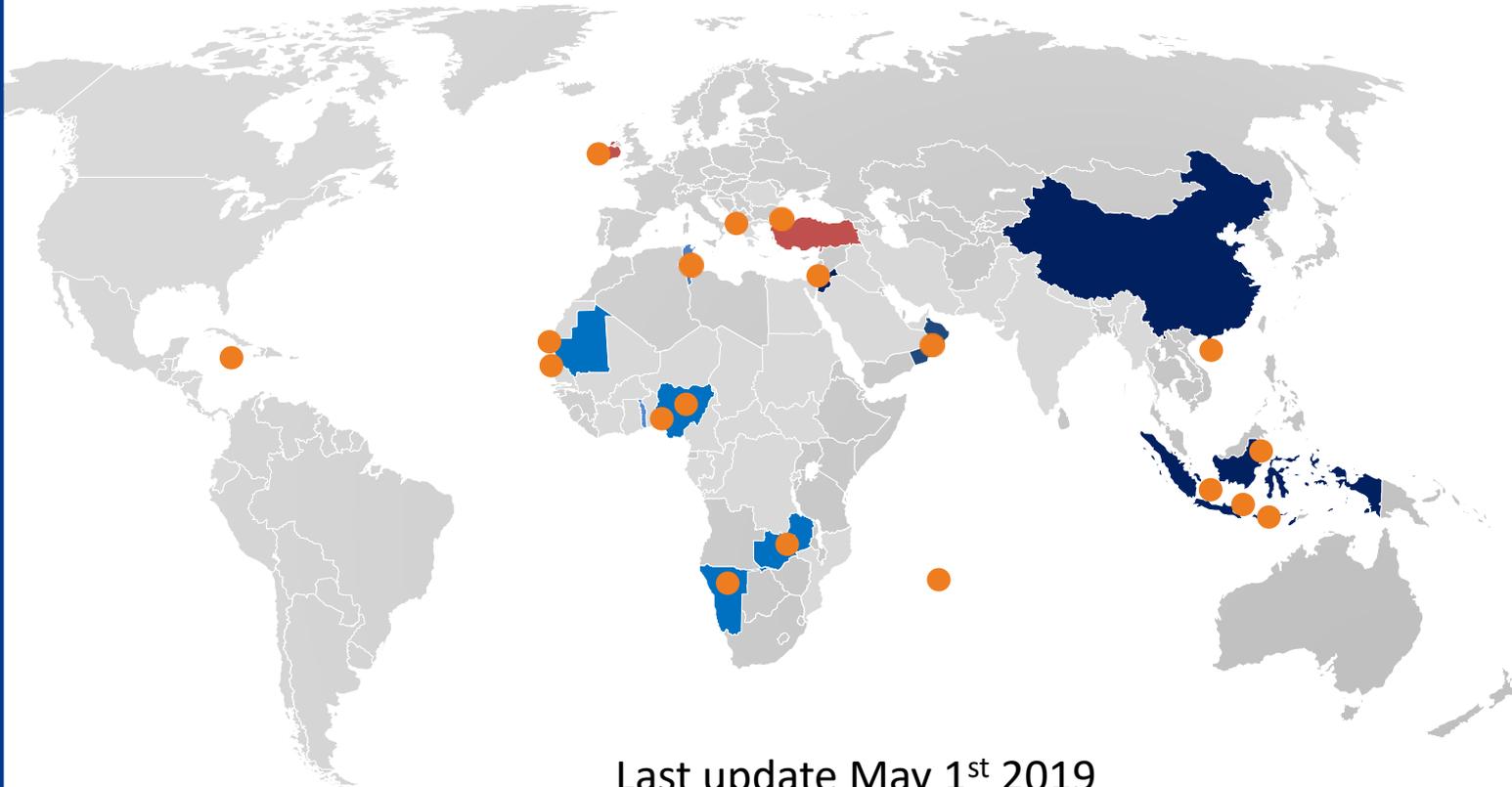

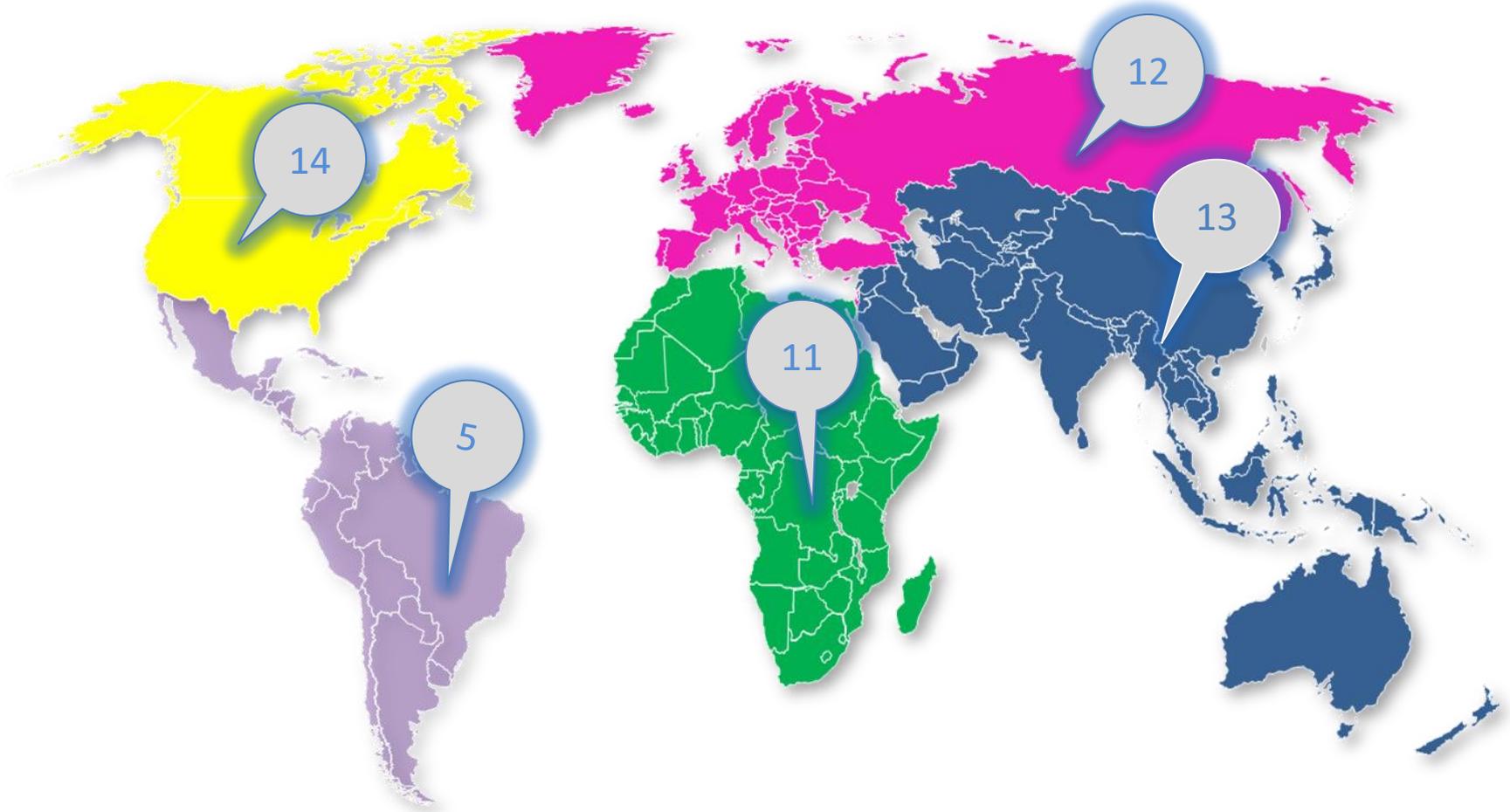
EU Partnership

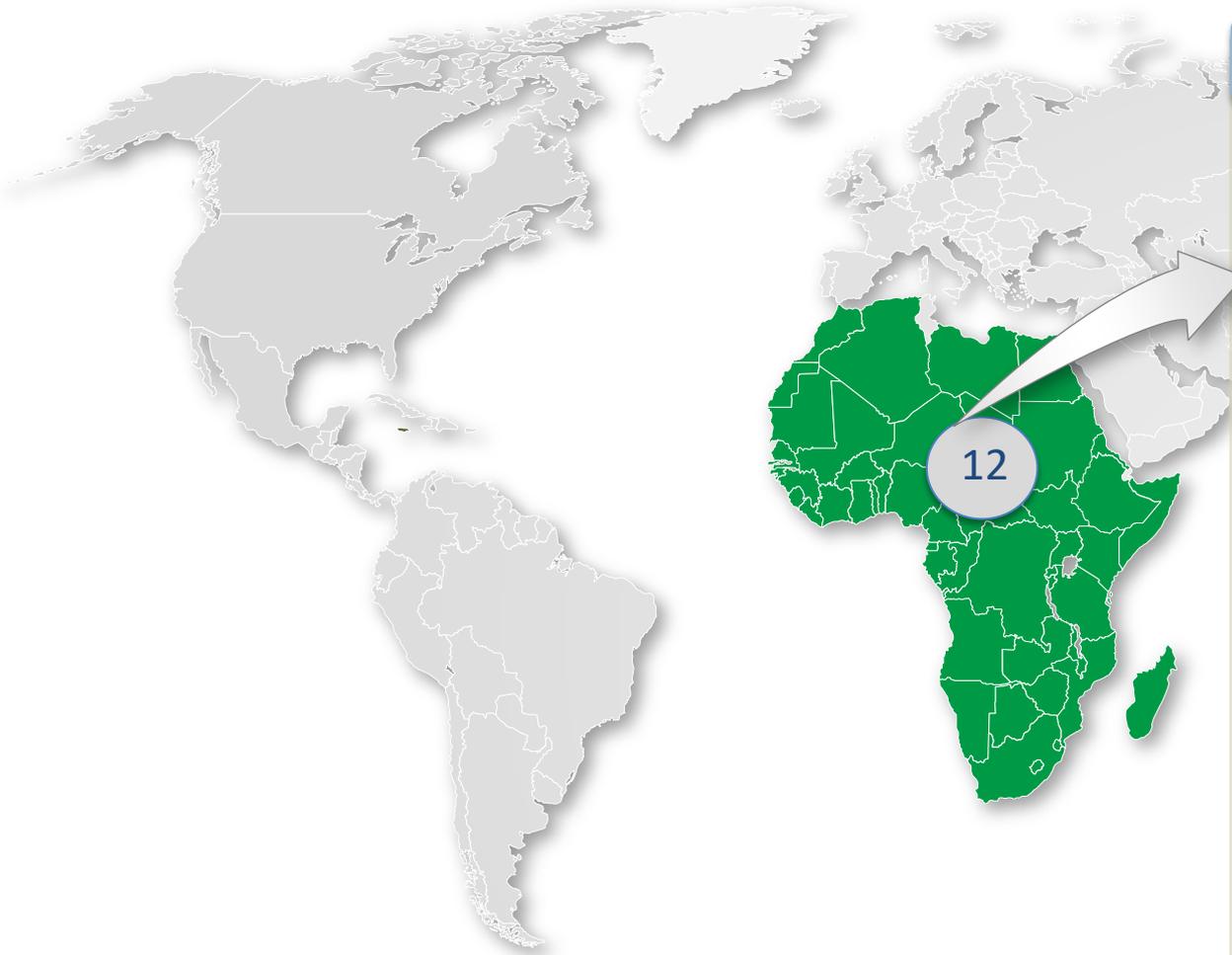


- Agreement with the Airports Council International (ACI) APEX in Security Programme and the European Union – DG MOVE
