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AANDD Development

AANDD was developed to assist in the enhancement process of identification, assessment, reporting and elimination of deficiencies in AFI Region.

AANDD provides an online secure management system to effectively manage deficiencies in the AFI Region in the various technical areas.



AANDD Development

In addressing and identifying deficiencies the following definition was used:

A deficiency is a situation where a facility, service or procedure does not comply with a regional air navigation plan approved by the Council, or with related ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs), and which situation has a negative impact on the safety, regularity and/or efficiency of international civil aviation.

(adopted by ICAO Council 30 Nov. 01)

Who can Use AANDD

- States shall designate One Focal Point to access AANDD.
- An official request shall be sent to ICAO ESAF and WACAF Regional Office to acquire AANDD access information (user name and password).
- The request shall include the name of the Focal Point, his/her title/position in the State CAA, contact information: e-mail address and telephone number.

AANDD- Secure Login

- As soon as the Login is pressed the system will notify the user about remember password option. For security reasons and for information confidentiality please do not use this option if you are working on a public computer or on a computer that is accessed by any other person than yourself.
- Pressing "yes" will make sure that you do not have to enter your login information every time you access the site.

This is the main interface of AANDD. The main web page of the system which will help users access any option they need to perform.

- On the top part of the screen a welcome message with the username will appear.
- Next to the welcome message is the Logout push button. Kindly use this button at the end of the session to make sure you terminated your session properly.



AANDD Users: States and Organizations have four main options.











The Add Deficiency Option provides the user with the facility to report a new deficiency in the appropriate Area. A new deficiency added to AANDD will always have an "N" status for New.



After the Add Deficiency button is clicked. The Following ICAO AFI Deficiencies reporting form will appear for the user to fill in the data according to ICAO deficiencies reporting rules and regulations.

AANDD User has to enter all the fields in the reporting form for the system to accept it. Any entry box left empty will not be accepted by the system. Kindly just enter "-" and do not leave the filed blank if you do not have information available for the entry box.



- The system will assist user in filling information by providing list boxes, date fields, check boxes and radio buttons.
- The system will notify the user as well in the event of any error by displaying the appropriate error message.



The first important information requested by the system is the Field to report in which technical area this deficiency will address. Users have to select one of the five options: AIM, AOP, ATM, CNS, MET and SAR.

The system will assist the user to enter the Date first reported and Date of Completion by providing an easy to use date Calendar. User will choose the Day, Month, and Year the deficiency was reported and when it is estimated to be completed.

Priority for Action



"A" priority = Top priority requirements necessary for air navigation safety.

Top priority requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is considered necessary for air navigation safety.

"B" priority = Intermediate requirements necessary for air navigation regularity and efficiency.

Intermediate priority requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is considered necessary for air navigation regularity and efficiency.

"U" priority = Urgent requirements having a direct impact on safety and requiring immediate corrective actions.

Urgent requirement consisting of any physical, configuration, material, performance, personnel or procedures specification, the application of which is urgently required for air navigation safety.



After reviewing all the information provided in the reporting form, the user will have to press the submit button at the end of the entry data.

- This will send an email to the officer in charge of the selected field to notify him/her that a new deficiency has been reported and needs approval.
- For example if the user reported a new deficiency in the AOP field. An email will be sent to ESAF or WACAF office AOP Officer to notify that a new Deficiency has been reported by State "XXX" in the AOP Field.
- As soon as the Officer in Charge accepts the Deficiency it will appear in the AANDD Database and will be available for users in the delete, update, search and print options.



- The Delete Deficiency option provides the user with the facility to delete a deficiency that has been corrected, rectified or resolved.
- After the Delete Deficiency button is clicked. All the deficiencies pertaining to the user will appear in a list format.
- Only Deficiencies with "N"- New or "C"- Current Status will be displayed. "D"- Deleted Status Deficiencies will not appear in this list.
- The user can select the deficiency to be deleted by pressing the appropriate deficiency in the item No. section. For example to delete the deficiency number 1. AIM click on the delete and the Delete Form icon for deficiency number 1 for AIM Angola will appear to the user.

- The user will review the information in the list and make sure this is the deficiency that has been corrected, rectified or resolved. The user will then press the delete button to delete the deficiency.
- On the Delete deficiency form, it is important to note the Rational for Non-Elimination Options DF DH DS WO where;
- ("F" = Financial Rational
- ("H" = Human Resources Rational
- (%) "S" = State (Military/political) Rational
- (a) "O" = Other unknown causes Rational
- After selecting the elimination option you then proceed to input the Remarks for Non Elimination.


- Deleting a deficiency will send a notification email to the officer in charge of the selected field to notify him/her that a deficiency has been deleted and needs approval.
- For example if the user deleted deficiency in the MET field. An email will be sent to ESAF or WACAF office MET Officer to notify that a Deficiency has been deleted by State "XXX" in the MET Field.
- As soon as the Officer in Charge accepts the delete Deficiency request it will appear in the AANDD Database and will show to users in the update, search and print options.
- This will send an email to the officer in charge of the selected field to notify him/her that a new deficiency has been reported and needs approval. Once approved, the deficiency will appear in the database list highlighted in yellow.




AANDD- Update Deficiency


AANDD- Search Deficiency

- To search deficiencies, click on the Search Deficiency icon and you will see the search filter options as displayed above. The search can be filtered by:
- "AREA" AIM, AOP, ATM, CNS, MET, SAR by clicking on the Area drop down menu.
- (STATUS" N, C, D or ALL
- **"PRIORITY" A, B, U**
- (GROUP BY" Either State or Area
- "DATE" Either Date First Reported or Date of Completion
- "KEYWORDS" by typing keyword that may be associated to a deficiency. Example: *Aerodrome*



AANDD- Date Property

To view the date properly as Day-Month-Year it is very important that users go to control panel. From the start menu choose control panel. Then choose Regional and Language Options.
