Dear Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that the Second Meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group for the AFI region (RASG-AFI/2) will be held at the ICAO Regional Office for Western and Central Africa (WACAF) in Dakar, Senegal on 1st and 2nd November 2013, and your Administration/Organization is being invited to this meeting.

You will recall that the first meeting of the AFI Regional Aviation Safety Group was held in Kampala, Uganda from 26 to 27 March 2012 as an outcome of which the overall RASG-AFI structure was adopted and Safety Support Teams (headed by Champions) created for the following priority projects viz Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs), Fundamentals of Safety Oversight (FSO), Accident Investigation (AI) and Emerging Safety Issues (ESI). It was also agreed that the future work programme of the Group would take into account various safety targets that were to be identified, developed and submitted for adoption by the Ministerial Conference on Aviation safety held in Abuja in July 2012.

In fact in March 2013, a Planning and Implementation Group (PIRG) and Regional Aviation Safety Group (RASG) Global Coordination Meeting was held at ICAO Headquarters in Montreal. One important outcome of the Montreal Meeting requires that all ICAO Regions set priorities and targets consistent with the Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP) and the Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP) whilst taking into account the specific needs of each region. Such safety targets have already been set by the Abuja Ministerial Conference held in July 2012, and endorsed by the African Union (AU) Heads of State and Government's Summit held in Addis Ababa in January 2013.

Collective safety performance of the Region must be improved; therefore, RASG-AFI/2 will review and adopt the terms of reference of the relevant subsidiary bodies which will assist in achieving the set safety targets for the Region. The Group will also select the required metrics and indicators to ensure that achievements are measured and reported regularly.

In line with the need for global coordination between RASGs on the one hand, and RASG's and PIRGs on the other, this second meeting of RASG-AFI will be preceded by APIRG/19 from 28 to 31 October 2013 at the same venue. The outcomes of the meetings of both Groups will be presented, also in Dakar, to the Fifth Meeting of AFI Directors General of Civil Aviation on 4th November 2013.



The meeting will review the conclusions and decisions of the First Meeting of the RASG-AFI.

Agenda Item 4: Review and approval of the draft Terms of Reference (TORs) of the Safety Support Teams:

The Group will review the Structure of RASG-AFI and the role of various bodies with the focus on the draft Terms of Reference for the four Safety Support Teams established by RASG-AFI/01 namely; the Significant Safety Concern (SSC), Fundamentals of Safety Oversight (FSO) and Accident Investigation (AI), Emerging Safety Issues (ESI) established during the First RASG-AFI Meeting

Agenda Item 5: Implementation of the Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP)

The Group will be presented with draft metrics developed for the purpose of measuring progress made towards the achievement of the safety targets.

2. Languages

The Meeting will be conducted in both English and French languages.

The Opening Session of the Meeting will take place at the ICAO WACAF office, where subsequent sessions will also be held.

4. Registration

In addition to submission of completed forms by e-mail, the registration of participants will take place at the site of the meeting on Sunday 13 October 2013 from 16:00 to 19:00 hours.

5. Weather and Clothing

The average minimum temperature in October in Dakar is 24.9°C with a maximum of 30.9°C. The mean total rainfall is 30.1 mm with an average of 4 days of rain. Light clothing is advisable during the meeting period.

6. Procedures for obtaining an entry visa for Senegal

Participants are to note that effective 1 July 2013, all applications for entry visas in Senegal will be made online prior to arrival. The website for online visa applications is operational. The visa applicant gets the options to be either pre-enrolled online or at the nearest Enrollment Center. If successful, the applicant will receive a confirmation document with a bar code and all relevant information. After a processing time of 48 hours, the applicant can withdraw the visa, either in one of Enrolment Centers or upon arrival at the airport of Dakar based on the "Pre-Visa" document.

Note: To avoid serious difficulties at the Leopold Sédar Senghor International Airport in Dakar, it is STRONGLY recommended that the applicant obtain an entry Visa, before travelling, to the closest enrolment center.

At this stage, 18 Enrolment Centers have been created in the following countries:

- Africa: South Africa, Cameroon, Gambia, Mauritania;
- Europe: Germany, Belgium, Spain, France, Italy, Russia;
- America: USA (Washington, New York)
- Asia: China, India

Note: For non-listed diplomatic representations, the visa will be issued at the Dakar airport after a successful pre-enrollment online.

Visas are not required for nationals from Economic Community Of West African States (ECOWAS).

7. Health

Participants are informed that a valid certificate of vaccination against yellow fever is required. The participants should ensure that they have applied for a valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their staying in Senegal.

8. Banking service

8.1 Banks are located not far away from the Airport and the ICAO Regional office and are opened from 07:40 to 12:15 hours and 13:40 to 15:45 hours from Monday to Friday. The basic unit of currency is FCFA. There are coins of 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 200, 250 and 500 FCFA. Notes are issued in denominations of 500, 1000, 2000, 5000 and 10 000 FCFA. The FCFA exchange rate is 1 Euro (€) (European currency) for 655.957 FCFA (~656 FCFA) and 1 USD fluctuates around 500 FCFA.

9. Hotels

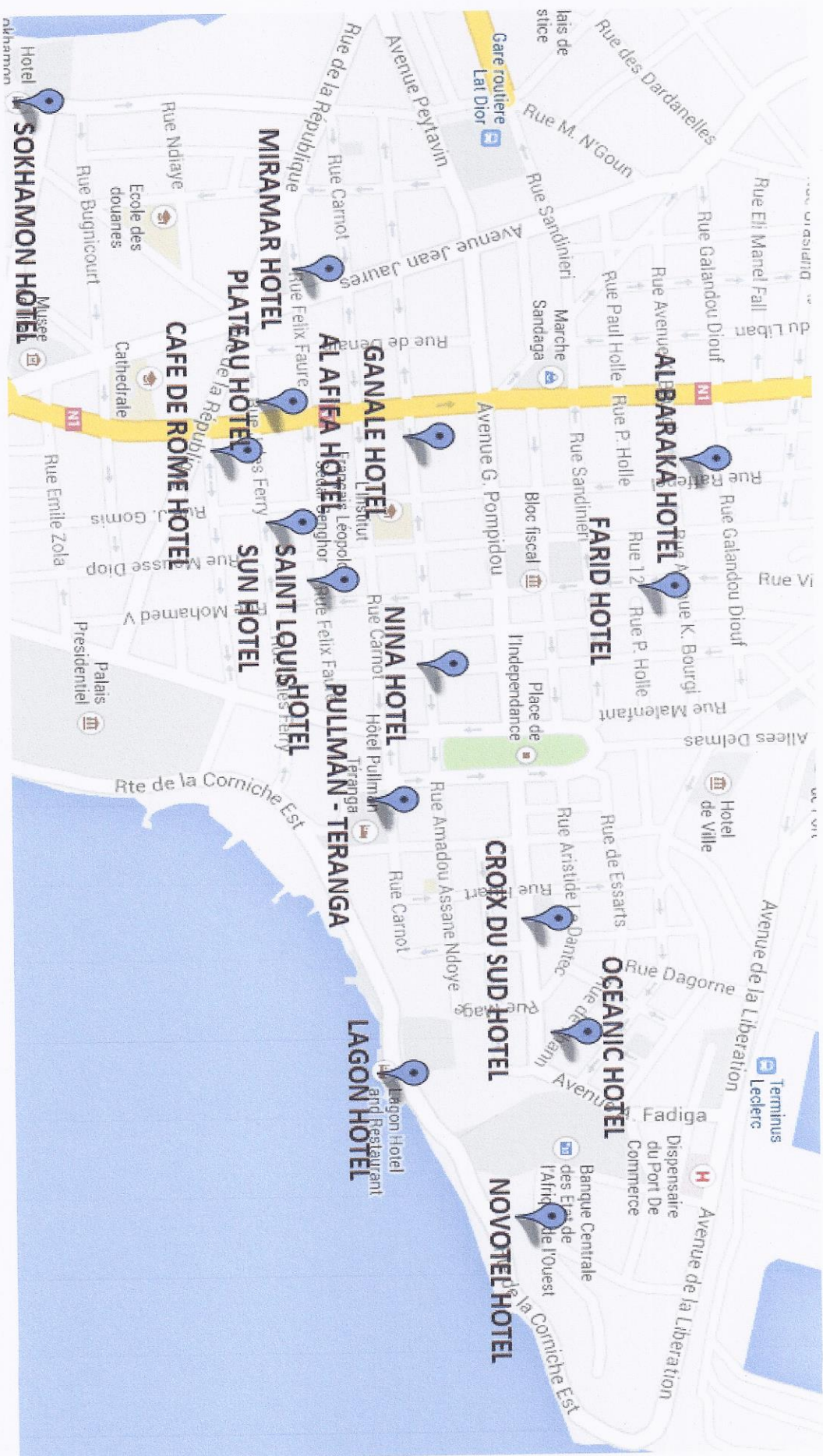
