Action required: Reply by 18 July 2005

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to draw your attention to the Conclusion 5/5 of the RVSM Stakeholders meeting held from 17 to 19 November 2004 in Dakar and the subsequent continued efforts to meeting the new Implementation date of 19 January 2006, ICAO will be holding the RVSM/TF/7 meeting from 8 to 9 August, 2005 at the ICAO WACAF Office, Dakar, Senegal.

This meeting will be followed thereafter from 10 to 12 August 2005 by APIRG ATM Sub-Group meeting at the same venue. Your Administration is kindly invited to participate in both meetings.

The main objective of the Task Force meeting is to review all work done by the RVSM Task Force including AFI RMA Tasks and make appropriate recommendations on the way forward to safe RVSM implementation in AFI continental airspace. The Agenda is at **Appendix A**.

The main objective of the ATM Sub-Group meeting amongst many others stipulated by APIRG/14 in the Terms of Reference and Work Programme of the Sub-Group, is to review work completed by the RVSM Implementation Task Force 7 which will include the NLR's Collision Risk Assessment (CRA). It is also expected that the Sub-group will consider the RVSM Pre-Implementation Safety Case (PISC) that will subsequently be submitted to APIRG/15 in September 2005. The Sub-group will determine whether the RVSM Implementation Target date of 19 January 2006 is still feasible. It is therefore essential for all ATM Sub-Group stakeholders to participate to ensure that all inputs are considered before making a decision that will have a major impact on the AFI Region. 1. Organization, Site and Dates

The Seventh Meeting of the AFI RVSM/RNAV/RNP/TF and the Eighth Meeting of ATM Sub-Group convened by the ICAO Regional Offices in Dakar and Nairobi, will be held in Dakar from 8 to 9 and 10 to 12 August 2005 respectively. The Task Force will be held at the DG ASECNA Conference Hall, ASECNA HQ, Dakar. Registration of the participants will start at 0830 hours on 8 August 2005.

3. Languages

The TF/7 meeting will be conducted in English language only while the AFI ATM Sub-Group will be in English and French languages.

4. Opening session

The opening session of the meetings will take place on Monday, 8 August 2005 at 0930 hours. The meeting's work schedule will be from 0900 - 1500 hours daily, subject to confirmation by the Meeting.

5. Registration

The registration of delegates/participants will take place at the meeting registration desk by the conference room on 8 August 2005 from 0830 hours.

6. Secretariat of the Meeting

Mr. Apolo Kharuga, Regional Officer ATM (RO/ATM) from the ICAO ESAF Office will be the Secretary of the meetings. Regional Officers in ATM and CNS fields from the ICAO WACAF Office will assist him.

7. Passport and VISA requirements

VISA is required for citizens from Non ECOWAS countries. To this effect, the concerned delegates are kindly requested to complete the formalities in advance in order to obtain entry visa from their Country's Senegal Embassy, prior to departure.

Delegates who anticipate difficulties with the immigration procedures should contact the ICAO Western and Central African Office for assistance.

8. Exchange Rate

The currency used in Sénégal is the Franc CFA (1EURO = 655.957 FCFA). The exchange of money should be made in banks or authorized places.

9. Transportation

The International airport of Léopold Sédar Senghor of Dakar is at about 15 km from downtown. Taxis are available at any time of the day. The charge is 3500 FCFA from the airport to downtown at daytime and is posted at arrival.

10. Health

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is mandatory. Visitor to Senegal arriving from cholera infected areas should have valid vaccination certificates.

11. Lodging

A list of selected hotels in Dakar is enclosed. The hotel rates quoted are subject to confirmation when making reservations.
