Frequency Management Workshop and the first meeting of AFI Frequency Management Group (Dakar, Senegal, 28 September - 2 October 2009)

Sir/ Madam,

I have the honor to invite you to a three day Frequency Management Workshop and a two day meeting of the AFI Frequency Management Group which will be held at the ICAO Regional Office for the Western and Central African Region in Dakar, Senegal, from 28 September to 2 October 2009. The main aim of the workshop is to introduce the new web based frequency management software currently being developed by ICAO to manage aviation frequency spectrum and SSR Mode S Interrogator Identifier (II) codes. The Workshop will deal with the following topics:-

- HF assignments;
- Coordination and assignment of SSR Mode S Interrogator Identifier codes; and;
- Frequency planning tool for CNS COM List 3.

Attachment A to this letter is the draft agenda for the workshop.

The first meeting of the AFI Frequency Management Group (AFI/FSMG) will take place after the Workshop from 1 to 2 October 2009. The meeting will address ICAO's position for WRC-11 and will also assist participants to draft their Civil Aviation position for ITU WRC-11 for inclusion in their State's position for submission through their respective National Radio Regulatory Authorities to the relevant meetings and conferences of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU). **Attachment B** is the draft agenda for the meeting.

Given the importance placed in Conclusion 14/15, 14/16, and 14/17 of the APIRG /14 meeting, Yaounde, Cameroon (23-27 June 2003), it will be highly appreciated if you could ensure participation at the above meeting by the designated Focal Point or Contact Person on

aeronautical spectrum matters. The work program and the Terms of Reference (TOR) for the AFI Frequency Management Group are attached hereto for your ease of reference (Attachment C).

Kindly be reminded that, in accordance with current ICAO policy to reduce costs, hard copy (paper) documentation at the meeting will be kept to a minimum, in favour of the use of multimedia projectors and electronic copies. Other than in exceptional cases, working/information papers and related documentation will not be provided in hard copy format.

In this regard, participants are advised to bring suitable computer equipment (such as laptops) and USB (removable) storage to the meeting.
