1. Introduction

The First Regional Workshop on the AFI ATS Message Handling System (AFI/AMS/WS/1) took place at the ICAO Eastern and Southern Regional office, United Nations Office, Nairobi, Gigiri, Kenya from, 17 to 18 May 2011.

2. Objectives

The main objective of the workshop was to provide an overview of the AMHS concept, system level provisions, detailed technical specifications and AFTN/AMHS gateway specifications, based on the provisions contained in ICAO Annex 10, Aeronautical Telecommunications, Volume III, Manual on Detailed Technical Specifications for the Aeronautical Telecommunication Network (ATN) using ISO/OSI Standards and Protocols (Doc 9880), and Manual on the Aeronautical Telecommunication Network (ATN) using Internet Protocol Suite (IPS) Standards and Protocols (Doc 9896).

3. Attendance

The meeting was attended by 32 participants from twelve (12) Contracting States, two (02) Air Navigation Service Providers (ASECNA acting behalf AFI 17 Contracting States & ATNS) and an AMHS facilities manufacturer, namely AVITECH from Germany. A list of participants is provided at **Appendix A**.
