Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to refer to the First Joint Meeting of AFI Aeronautical VSAT Networks Managers, which was held in Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa, from 13 to 15 June 2011. The meeting particularly welcomed ASECNA's offer to host a second meeting intended to assess the progress made in the development of a regional project on an AFI integrated aeronautical telecommunication infrastructure, and accordingly develop proposals and recommendations for consideration at the next APIRG meeting.

- I am pleased to inform you that ASECNA has confirmed their offer to host the Second Joint Meeting of AFI Aeronautical VSAT Networks Managers in Douala, Cameroon, from 29 February to 1 March 2012, and your Administration/Organization is hereby invited to participate.
- The main objective of the meeting is to review and update the characteristics and operational performance of AFI VSAT networks, assess progress made in the development of a regional project on an AFI integrated aeronautical telecommunication infrastructure by the Task Force established by the First Joint Meeting, review the outcome of the ITU WRC-2012 with respect to international protection of C-Band, and prepare a report to be presented to APIRG/18 Meeting (Kampala, Uganda, 27-30 March 2012). The Provisional Agenda (WP/1) and Information Bulletin (IP/1) for the meeting are attached hereto as Appendices A and B, respectively. The terms of reference of the Task Force on VSAT Networks are also attached as Appendix C. The meeting will be conducted in English language only and documentation will be issued in this language.

INFORMATION BULLETIN

1. VENUE

1.1 The Second Meeting of the AFI Aeronautical VSAT Networks Managers (AFI/VSAT/2) will be held at the Hotel SAWA, 488 rue du Verdum – Bonanjo, Cameroon, from 28 February to 1 March 2012.

2. REGISTRATION

- 2.1 The participants are requested to pre-register by filling the attached registration form and sending by fax or e-mail to icaowacaf@dakar.icao.int, KOMGUEMMAGNIApo@asecna.org
- 2.2 Based on the duty completed pre-registration form received by the secretariat, name badges will be issued on site. Participants will be required to reconfirm their registration at the registration desk on 28 February 2012 (08:30-09:30 Hours), during the first day of the meeting.

3. OPENING SESSION

3.1 The official opening of the Second Meeting of the AFI Aeronautical VSAT Networks Managers (AFI/VSAT/2) will take place on 28 February 2012 at 09:30. The formal meeting will be held daily from 08:30 a.m.

4. WORKING LANGUAGE AND DOCUMENTS

- 4.1 The workshop will be conducted in English with translation into French.
- 4.2 In order to avoid paper waste and to save the environment, all the meeting documents will be available online and displayed by video projector.
- 4.3 Participants are kindly requested to bring laptops.

5. HOTEL INFORMATION

5.1 Participants are requested to make their own hotel reservations. A list of recommended hotels is attached.

6. TRANSPORTATION

- 6.1 Douala International Airport is situated about 4 kilometers (about 8 minutes drive) from the city centre. Taxis are readily available; the taxi fare from the airport to the city centre is between FCFA 3000-5000.
- 6.2 Transport to and from the **Hotel SAWA** could be provided to all participants at their request. The practical organization for the transport will be precised after participants' arrival and accommodation.

7. VISA

7.1 While all travelers arriving in Cameroon should have a valid passport, Cameroon entry visas are required. Participants are therefore advised to ascertain whether or not they are exempt from visa requirements at the respective Cameroon embassies.

8. HEALTH

- 8.1 Participants must ensure they take out travel insurance (including health) from their home country for the duration of their stay in Cameroon.
- 8.2 Presentation of yellow fever certificate at the point of entry is highly required for all participants.

9. WEATHER AND LOCAL TIME INFORMATION

- 9.1 During February and March, the average temperature is 28.5°C; mean minimum temperature is 25°C and mean maximum is 32°C.
- 9.2 The local time in Cameroon territory is Universal Time +1 (UTC+1) or GMT+1 time.

10. LOCAL CURRENCY AND FOREIGN EXCHANGES RATES

- 10.1 The national currency in Cameroon is the Francs CFA. There are coins of 5 FCFA, 10 FCFA, 25 FCFA, 50 FCFA, 100 FCFA, and 500 FCFA. Notes are issued in denominations of 1000, 2000, 5000 and 10000 FCFA.
- 10.2 The exchange rate EURO/CFA is constant 1Euro for 655,957 FCFA.
- 10.3 Commercial banks provide exchange facilities. Most banks are open between 07:30 a.m to 15:30 p.m from Monday to Friday.

11. ELECTRICAL SUPPLY

11.1 Local voltage is 220/240V 50 Hz with French plugs. Participants from countries using English plugs may bring suitable plugs for their laptops.

12. TELEPHONES

- 12.1 Worldwide direct connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator if necessary.
- 12.2 From abroad dial +237 followed by required number. There are several mobile operators including MTN, ORANGE, and CAMTEL.

TASK FORCE ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL PROJECT ON AN AFI INTEGRATED AERONAUTICAL TELECOMMUNICATION INFRASTRUCTURE TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Vision

- a) Continue to improve safety within the AFI region.
- b) Enhance AFI Aeronautical Infrastructure safety.
- c) Improve the contribution of infrastructure in AFI safety endeavours.
- d) To enhance contribution of aeronautical communications infrastructure in the AFI region.
- e) Enhancement of safety through elimination of deficiencies associated with AFI aeronautical infrastructure.

2. Objectives

- a) Develop a sustainable and integrated/interoperable VSAT networks to provide aeronautical telecommunications services in AFI region;
- b) Upgrade technical capabilities of the networks to comply with the ICAO SARPs and guidance material, user requirements and global best practices;
- c) Ensure financial sustainability of the networks through equitable and fair allocation of costs to states and users;
- d) Create harmonious and seamless administrative oversights for the networks;
- e) Enlist states' commitment to this initiative;
- f) Achieve the ATN concept for AFI; and
- g) Apply appropriate costs-effective technologies.

- b) Architectural requirements; Recommendations for a road-map, to be implemented by States; and
