- Background

Entry and Exit Health Screening (EESS)

- EEHS SOP produced by Sierra Leone Civil Aviation Authorities and Airport Authorities, MOHS, and supported and guided by US CDC
- CDC funded IOM HHBM project to enforce EEHS SOP
 - Monitored/Supported Health Screening for 100% Travellers - 100,000+ since 01 Nov 2014
 - Training Airport Agency Staff in EEHS SOP
 - Data and Stock Management

Health and Humanitarian Border Management — Health Security

Many Lines of Defense for Health Security

- Staff commuting from EVD areas identified as greatest threat to airport health security
- Additional outer ring of basic health screening for anyone entering the airport site – 24 hour
- IOM monitoring covers entire airpory site – 24 hour
- ISAT digital mapping of addresses / quarantien overlay
- 5 isolation rooms, 2 ambulances, 1 recieving ETU for consistancy in referral practices






