Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to inform you that Kenya, as Africa-Indian Ocean Regional Aviation Safety Group (RASG-AFI) Champion for Emerging Safety Issues Support Team for Loss of Control in-Flight (LOC-I) and Ethiopia as a hosting State with the support of the ICAO Eastern and Southern African (ESAF) Regional Office, are co-organizing a LOC-I and upset prevention and recovery training (UPRT) Workshop in Ethiopia from 19 to 21 December 2016 at the Ethiopian Airlines Aviation Academy, Addis Ababa.

This Workshop is a follow-up of the LOC-I Symposium organized in Nairobi from 22 to 24 June 2015, which resulted in a set of recommendations as a way forward, among which a 5-year action plan endorsed by the third RASG-AFI meeting that was held in Yamoussoukro, Ivory Coast from 3 to 4 December 2015. It focusses at advancing the agenda on LOC-I aiming at circumventing related accidents as per Abuja Safety Targets.

The programme of the workshop will include the latest developments on UPRT, the presentation of the 5-year plan of action on LOC-I, some guidance on implementing recommendations from the Nairobi LOC-I Symposium and a practical session on a UPRT compliant flight simulation training device (FSTD). A detailed programme including an information bulletin will be provided in due course.

The target audience includes civil aviation inspectors in operations of aircraft, personnel licensing and safety from civil aviation administrations, aircraft incidents and accidents investigators from accidents investigation authorities and pilots, instructors and other operations personnel from air operators and training organizations. In this regard, your administration is kindly requested to extend to the latter this invitation letter.
