In this respect, Kenya, as the designated champion for LOC-I, with the support of the ESAF Regional Office as Secretariat and coordinator, organized a LOC-symposium that was held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 22 to 24 June 2015. This event was convened under the framework of a project proposal for RASG-AFI LOC-I Team Implementation, which was developed by the Champion with the support of the ESAF Regional Office.

The third RASG-AFI meeting held in Yamoussoukro, Cote d'Ivoire from 3 to 4 December 2015 endorsed a 5-year Plan of action for LOC-I. Furthermore other recommendations to improve flight safety were also presented.

As a follow-up of the LOC-I Symposium held in Nairobi, a LOC-I and UPRT Workshop was co-organized in Addis Ababa by the Regional Office and Ethiopia from 19 to 21 December 2016.

The activities we are presently having in Johannesburg consist of a core training for CAA inspectors and air operators' and training organizations' instructors in the area of UPRT, as provided for in the RASG-AFI 5-year plan of action for LOC-I. This will be followed by a seminar that will address evolutions in related ICAO guidance material and status of implementation of related SARPs.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I expect that this Workshop and Seminar will enhance your knowledge and skills at various levels within Civil Aviation Authorities and Industry and therefore would like to call upon each one of you in your individual capacities to improve aviation system within your domain and employ best practices in order to implement UPRT and mitigate LOC-I occurrences.

Once again, I would like to express my gratitude on the South African Authorities for hosting this event and for providing all the necessary facilities.

I would like also to extend this to the FAA and all the facilitators for their support and dedication and for sharing their knowledge, skills and experiences on LOC-I and UPRT.
