THE CURRENT ENVIRONMENT

Role of the Regulator:

- It is up to the Regulator to develop the Regulations, Technical Guidance Material (TGM) and other related documents; Inspect, Audit and Certify the AISP.
- Presently, Regulator amendment of Regulations to accommodate the new Annex 15 and PANS-AIM

Role Players:

AIS Head of Department:

- . Guarantees the completion of the verification of the proposed AIP amendments; Inspectors:
- . verify AIP's proposed amendments and issue opinions

AISP:

It is the responsibility of the AISP to comply with the provisions of the regulations, TGMs and other related documents

Role Players:

- Technical personel receive stakeholder information about any correction or request for publication of new information;
- Technicians evaluate the information to be amended or published and duly advise the Head of Department;

- Submit the proposed amendment to the Regulator for approval;
- If approved, it will be published, if not approved, the cycle begins again.

► Aeronautical Information Services were transferred in 2014 from Regulator to AISP through an MoU which included AIP Services (Integrated Aeronautical Information Package, AIP Amendments) and NOTAMS.

NOTAM service was consolidated in the same year, 2014, and is installed at Maputo International Airport.

Implementation of the MoU

Dynamic Part (NOTAM) - Consolidated in 2014

Static Part (AIP) - Effective consolidation expected during the 1st Quarter of 2020 through the publication of the 4th edition of AIP Mozambique in digital format.

Interaction between the MOZCAA and AISP

AIP Amendment Process:

- ► AISP submits to MOZCAA Amendment Proposal;
- Regulator carries out AIP assessment and amendment analysis, in coordination with other Departments.
- Regulator reverts the AIP Amendment proposal to AIS Provider for correction, if needed or for publication

- Regulator submits to ANSP the AIP Amendment Letter of Approval
- Publication and Distribution of AIP Amendment to Subscribers, largely by email.

Final Product:

Publication of AIP Amendment, adhering to the AIRAC Dates and issue AIRAC NIL when needed.
