Objective

 aeronautical information/data provided is adequate, timely and is of the required quality.

SCOPE

- Uganda Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP), including amendment services,
- Supplements to the AIP, and
- NOTAM
- Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC)
- Aeronautical Charts
- Static database for the purpose of producing digital data sets

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Regulator responsible for implementation of this procedure
- Data Originators
 - Obtaining approval for the data from CAA
 - Notification of inaccuracies in aeronautical information service (AIS) publications:
 - For changes planned in advance: notifying AIS and the CAA, in writing, at least 70 days

Responsibilities (contd)

 Notification for planned temporary changes to CAA at least 48hours in advance of the effective date,

 Submit both permanent and temporary data and information to the AIS on the Aeronautical Information Promulgation Advice Form to be obtained from the AIM website https://aim.caa.co.ug.

Regulatory Approval Process

- data originator forwards the request for promulgation to Director Safety, Security and Economic Regulation (DSSER) for consideration
- Upon submission of the Aeronautical Data to the DSSER, the request shall be forwarded to the ANS Inspectorate for coordination with appropriate department/Section if regulatory approval is required.
- Approve the aeronautical data for publication by AIS; or
- Engage with the Authorised data originator if approval is denied

Approval process contd

 upon receipt of the approval of the data from the respective department/section, the ANS inspectorate forwards the aeronautical data/information to AIS for analysis, processing and promulgation

Information Approved

- Controlled/Regulated Airspace
- Ground/Satellite based Navigation Systems
- Instrument Flight Procedures
- VHF/UHF frequencies
- Danger/Restricted Areas
- Civil/Military Aerodrome Traffic Zones
- Aerodrome Runway Declared Distances
- Aerodrome Rescue & Fire Fighting categories

Challenges

Late submission of information

Incomplete information and inaccurate information

Information which does not qualify for promulgation

Misuse of publication of the IAIP especially NOTAM
