## CAPSCA Africa - Activities

- Seventh Meeting of the CAPSCA-Africa held in Livingstone, Zambia from 24 to 26 July 2017
- CAPSCA Focal Points COVID-19 status update meeting (virtual) held in April 2020
- 20 States/Airports Assistance visits conducted since 2014
  - Uganda, Guinea Bissau, Côte d'Ivoire, Mali, Burkina Faso, Sierra Leone, Guinea, Ghana, Nigeria, Liberia, Benin, Togo, Mauritania, DR Congo, Gambia, Cameroon, Niger, Equatorial Guinea, Senegal and Cape Verde.
- 6 Follow up AVs conducted since 2017
  - Sierra Leone, Liberia, Nigeria, Guinea, Mali and Senegal.
- Training of new technical advisors



## CAPSCA Africa - Activities

- Support to WHO's Assessment of designated Point of Entry in Nigeria, Cabo Verde and Morocco
- Several joint ICAO-WHO trainings (Dakar – 2015, Accra – May and November 2017, Harare – October 2018 and Johannesburg – February 2019)
- Support provided to States for their participation in several virtual training initiatives organized by South Africa
- Joint ICAO-WHO statements, webinars and virtual training in support to the management of EVD and COVID-19
- Provision of guidance and tools as well as advise to States in support to the management of EVD and COVID-19 pandemic
- Support to Organizations' initiatives (RECs, AFCAC, AU, Africa CDC, ...)





  - 11 Recommendations – CART Phase I
  - **Three new Recommendations**
  - **TOGD, second Edition**
  - **Reviewed Testing and cross-border risk management Manual (Doc 10152)**
- **CART Phase III - SL 2021/21, 17 March 2021**
  - 14 Recommendations – CART Phase I and Phase II
  - **Six new and two revised Recommendations**
  - **TOGD, third Edition**
- **CART Phase III bis – SL 2021/64, 5 October 2021**
  - 20 Recommendations – CART Phase I
  - **Four revised Recommendations**
  - **TOGD, Fourth Edition**
  - **Reviewed Testing and cross-border risk management Manual (Doc 10152, 3rd edition)**


Implementation Status per State



Implementation Status per State




## Public Health Risk Mitigation Measures Level of adoption – ESAF States

Status of Measure Adoption per State




## Public Health Risk Mitigation Measures Level of adoption – WACAF States

## COVID19 - Support to the Implementation

- **DG CAAs Meetings & Assistance**
  - Remote assistance through VTC.
- **Trainings, Workshops, Webinars**
- **Guidance**
  - Documentation and support
- **Implementation Packages (iPACKs)**
  - Bundle of **guidance material, training, tools, expert** assistance and, when applicable, procurement guidance
  - Aims at **facilitating and guiding the implementation of the applicable ICAO provisions and recommendations** (<http://www.icao.int/iPACK>)
  - FAL iPacks implemented in **Sierra Leone, the Gambia, Eswatini, Namibia and Mauritania**
  - Ongoing implementation of PHC iPacks in **Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Mozambique, Senegal and Togo**



## Way forward

- All the States to **nominate CAPSCA National Focal Points**
- **Coordination** between **CAPSCA National Focal Point** and **CRRIC Focal Point** if not the same
- **Coordination** between **CAPSCA Focal Point** and the **National Air Transport Facilitation Committees**
- States to improve the implementation of **CART Recommendations** and request for assistance when necessary
- **Coordination Aviation & Public Health** to be strengthened at regional and National Level
- Need to review the CAPSCA framework to **incorporate new key players** brought by the COVID-19 pandemic (at national, regional and global level)
