
1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. In accordance with the provisions of the APIRG Procedural Handbook, the Sub-Group records the outcomes of its meetings in the form of Conclusions and Decisions with the following significance:

- a) Conclusions deal with the matters which, in accordance with the Group’s terms of reference, merit directly the attention of States for further actions to be undertaken in accordance with established procedures; and
 - b) Decisions deal with matters of concern only to the APIRG and its subsidiary bodies.
- 1.2. Set of these conclusions and decisions that the Sub-group deems relevant might be selected for submission to the next APIRG meeting if there are changes in their status.
 - 1.3. Furthermore, the Sub-group at each of its meetings, reviews the status of the implementation previous conclusions and decisions. Depending on the outcomes of the conclusions and decisions pertaining to the mandate of the Sub-group, States and organizations are recurrently urged to ensure expeditious closure of the open items.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1. The Sub-group at each meeting proceed with the reviews the status of the implementation of conclusions and decisions of its previous meeting and the APIRG conclusions and decisions applicable to the Sub-group.
- 2.2. The figure 1 provides an overview of the status of the implementation of conclusions and decisions of the Sub-group and APIRG conclusions and decisions applicable to the Sub-group.



- 2.3. The number of pending conclusions and decisions range from 3 to 14 while the number of completed items range 3 to 9.
- 2.4. Meetings urged States and Organizations to take necessary actions to address the outstanding conclusions and decisions, but no analysis of the relevancy of those pending issues is made to confirm their relevancy and decide to include those recognized as relevant in the outcomes of the current meeting.

2.5. As consequences of the above, number of conclusions and decisions are left behind or are reformulated as outcomes of the following meetings.

2.6. Proposal is made for each meeting of the Sub-group, to evaluate the relevance of the pending conclusions and decisions of the previous in the view to incorporating those still valid into the outcomes of the current and cancelling the others deemed not relevant.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

3.1. The meeting is invited to :

- a) take note of information contained in this paper;
- b) identify the outstanding conclusions and decisions and the key actors to address these findings.
