Long Term Traffic Forecasts (Africa)





- Passenger traffic 2019-2050 forecast is 3.8% overall (3.7% for international traffic, 4.9% for domestic traffic)
- Traffic is expected to increase continuously
- Forecast for cargo similar
- Air traffic has recovered to pre-COVID level



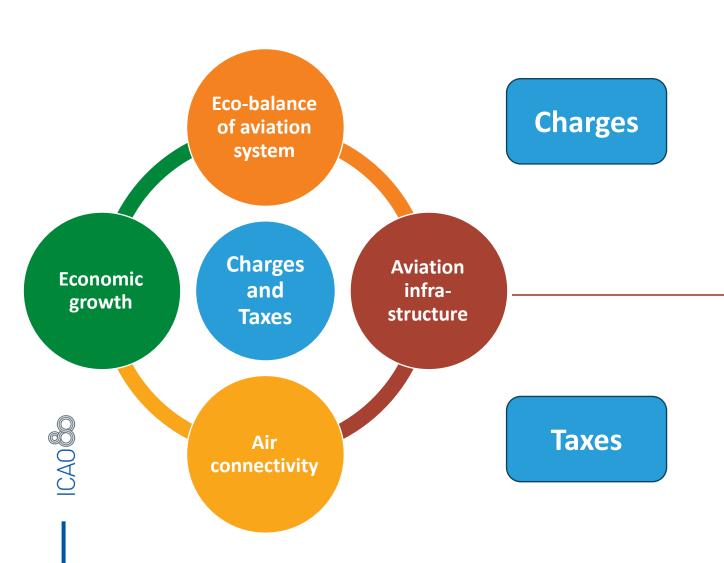
Intra-African Connectivity

- Figures based on direct connections between all countries of two regions: actual number of connections vs. possible number of connections
- Connectivity improving, now above pre-COVID level
- Higher connectivity within regions \Leftrightarrow lower connectivity between regions

Balance between the interests of airports, ANSPs, airlines and passengers

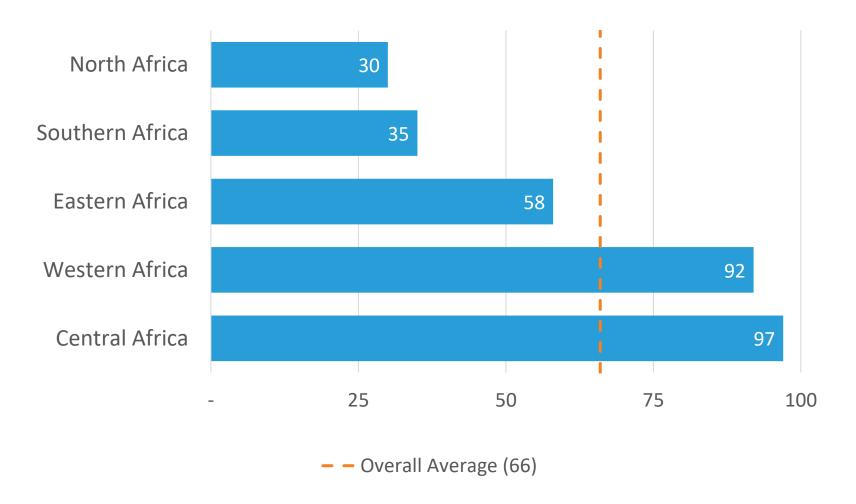
Implementation of ICAO's Policies on Taxation on International Air Transport (Doc 8632)

ICAO and **SAATM**

- Resolution A41-27 "Requested the Council to continue to cooperate with regional and sub-regional bodies in the examination and development of measures of cooperation, including liberalized arrangements, and the results of these measures, in order to see whether similar or other measures should at the appropriate time be recommended to Member States for application on a wider basis."
- ICAO commend the advancements made by many African States and the efforts of AFCAC towards the implementation of the SAATM, and the move for Yamoussoukro Decision (YD) compliant Air Services Agreement (ASA) that includes the following aspects*:
 - (i) Market access up to 5th Freedom Rights
 - (ii) Liberalized air tariffs
 - (iii) Unrestricted capacity and frequency
 - (iv) Full liberalization for air cargo services
 - (v) Adherence to the uniform rules for fair competition, consumer protection and dispute settlement
- Two strategic issues for considerations to ensure the success of SAATM:
 - (i) Take into consideration of aviation's crucial role when defining **national policy** and **spending priorities**
 - (ii) Recognize the ways and extend that **protectionism** transpires and **impacts economic** and **social progress**
- ICAO has been and will continue to provide supports to AFCAC and African Member States in realizing SAATM:
 - ✓ Provisions of **guidance**, **trainings and advisory** through continued close collaborations with AFCAC and African Member States
 - ✓ Platforms for Member States to conduct **negotiations** during the annual ICAO Air Services Negotiation Event (ICAN)
 - Avenue for AFCAC to conduct workshops during ICAN
