An opportunity to reflect on the achievements and challenges related to the development of international aviation in the Region and encourage sustained progress towards a more sustainable future for the aviation industry.




Celebrating the past and advocating for the safe, secure, and sustainable development of aviation extending access to those who need it most while ensuring that we do not compromise on these imperatives.


