1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The ICAO requirement for operators to install or modify their TCAS equipment to version 7.1 became effective as far back as 2017 but today there seems to be no central record to shows the status of implementation among the forty-eight (48) States in AFI. States were meant to have either amended regulations to this effect or implemented them if they did not exist in the first place.

2. DISCUSSIONS

- 2.1 There is general increase of TCAS Resolution Advisories (TCAS RA) as reported by operators and as one of the mitigation measures States need to implement this requirement.
- **2.2** IATA is requesting feedback from all States regarding their status on implementation of this requirement.
