ICAO Regional Director for South America Region

Mr. Hoyer was appointed ICAO's Regional Director for South America in 2009. Born in Brazil (1953), he is a retired Officer of the Air Force with more than 36 years of service and holds a post-graduate degree in High Studies on Policy and Strategy. Since 1985 has worked in the fields of air navigation and air transport. He represented his country in various ICAO activities, as well as in ITU and OAS-CITEL, among others.



He was Alternate Representative of Brazil on the ICAO Council, Member of the ICAO Air Navigation Commission and Member of the ICAO Aeronautical Communications Panel. After his retirement from the Air Force in 2006, Mr. Hoyer joined the newly created National Civil Aviation Agency (ANAC), the CAA of Brazil, where he was in charge of the negotiations of the Air Services Agreements and the liaison with International Organizations. He left ANAC as Superintendent of International Affairs to assume the current position.

Mr. Hoyer is also the General Coordinator of the Regional Safety Oversight Cooperation System (SRVSOP), a Latin American Regional Safety Oversight Organization (RSOO).
