Further types of needs: More International Cooperation, sharing of information, experience and best practices with other States - meetings, workshops, seminars





COVID-19 Recovery needs identified

Training needs

- The need for collaboration and exchange with other States on best practices (meetings, workshops)
- Shortage of Financial Resources
- > The need for contactless technical means for the implementation of aviation security measures in the times of the pandemic
- Quality Control activities in times of COVID-19
- Cybersecurity
- Landside Security
- Security Culture
- Disruptive Passengers
- Innovations (equipment to detect biological agents)

Several Covid-19 recovery needs are similar to the general prevailing needs in AVSEC, just specifically focused taking the sanitary situation into account. The needs shown in orange developed because of the pandemic







Conclusions

- There is a number of available capacity building opportunities which match the identified needs;
- > States with a need can contact the ICAO EUR/NAT office which is happy to connect this State with a State or Organization providing a matching capacity building offer
- Not every capacity building activity is available in every ICAO language spoken in the region, some are only available in national languages; however there is a good amount available in one or more languages spoken in the region
- > States experience more difficulties in areas where training/capacity building opportunities are limited e.g. Landside Security (however, also there is training available);
- States point out the need for continuous international cooperation and exchange.
