capital Astana and the historic city of Almaty.



Passport and visa requirements

Foreign guests enter and leave the Republic of Kazakhstan through checkpoints at the state border using passports or documents replacing them, if requthey should have Kazakhstani visas. As of June 2024, citizens of 82 countries can enter Kazakhstan without visas. You can find out more detailed information about the visa regime for foreign citizens by clicking here



Visa-free regime:

Citizens of many countries do not require a visa to visit Kazakhstan for up to 30 days. A complete list of visa-free countries can be found on the official website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Kazakhstan or clarified at the Embassy/Consulate of Kazakhstan in your country.



E-visa:

For citizens of certain countries, an electronic visa (e-visa) is available, which can be obtained online. This is a convenient option for those planning their trip in advance. More details on Visa-migration portal of the Republic of Kazakhstan



Visa on arrival:

In some cases, for example, for citizens of countries that do not have a visa-free regime and do not have the opportunity to apply for an electronic visa, a visa can be issued upon arrival at Almaty airport. However, it is recommended to clarify this information in advance with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to avoid unforeseen situations.

General information

Money, Exchange Rates

The national currency in Kazakhstan is the tenge (KZT). Goods and services must be paid for in tenge. It's recommended to exchange US dollars, Euros or other currencies at banks or official exchange offices for better rates. ATMs are widely available throughout the city. Bank cards (Visa, Mastercard, UnionPay, American Express) are accepted in most urban areas, but cash is advisable for travel outside cities. Cash amount exceeding 10,000 USD must be declared at customs, except for cash from/to Eurasian Customs Union member states. You can always find the current exchange rates by following the link


Weather in Kazakhstan


Kazakhstan's climate is extremely continental, with cold winters (-4°C to -19°C in January) and hot summers (+19°C to +26°C in July). Almaty's weather in November usually is cold (-2°C to +1°C) with 3 to 8 days of rain expected. It's a good idea to bring warm clothes and an umbrella.


General information

PLUGS

Kazakhstan uses European standard sockets (C, E, F types) with 220 Volt/50 Hz. Most European travelers (except UK) and travelers from India, Turkey, Tunis won't need adapters. Travelers from the USA, Japan, and other countries with different standards should bring adapters. If forgotten, charging points with various plugs are available at major airports. Adapters can also be purchased at electronics stores in major cities.







Sights

Kok-Tobe: Take a cable car to the top of Kok-Tobe Hill to enjoy stunning views of the city, visit the amusement park and see the famous Beatles monument.

2 Big Almaty Lake: Take a scenic trip to this high-altitude lake, surrounded by snow-capped peaks. It's the perfect spot for picnics, walks and photography

Medeu & Shymbulak: Visit Medeu, the world's highest skating rink and take the gondola up to Shymbulak ski resort for more breathtaking views and hiking opportunities (even in summer!).



Cultural experiences

Central State Museum of Kazakhstan: Explore the rich history and culture of Kazakhstan through the museum's extensive collection of artifacts and exhibits.

2 State Opera and Ballet Theater: Catch a performance of opera or ballet in this grand theater, a cultural landmark of Almaty.
