



Domestic aviation represents flights which depart and arrive within the same country. International aviation emissions are assigned to the country of departure.






VOLUME OF TRANSIT FLIGHTS



Kazakhstan Becomes First CIS Country to Join ICAO Program on Sustainable Aviation Fuels



ASTANA – Kazakh Vice Minister of Transport Talgat Lastayev and Regional Director for the International Civil Aviation Organization's (ICAO) European and North Atlantic Office Nicolas Rallo signed an agreement on Assistance, Capacity-building and Training (ACT) for Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAF) on May 13, reported Kazakhstan's Civil Aviation Committee.









Preliminary Kazakhstan's State Action Plan to reduce CO2 in civil for the period 2024-2027 aims at:

- a) Limiting CO2 emissions from civil aviation activities starting with 2020;
- b) Informing the aircraft operators and ANSP and Airport operators on technologies promoted internationally;
- **Encouraging involvement of national** aviation stakeholders in international and national projects aiming at reducing GHG emissions.
