<u>United Nations:</u> "Sustainable development meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs."



The three dimensions of sustainability










Minimize the adverse effect of global civil aviation on the environment



- Market-based measures (MBMs)
- Sustainable alternative Fuels







States' Action Plans to reduce aviation CO₂ emissions

For States

Opportunity to identify and communicate measures to address ${\rm CO_2}$ emissions from international aviation as well as any assistance needs to implement the measures



For ICAO

Assess the global progress towards the achievement of aspirational goals and address specific assistance needs of States.






States' Action Plans - ICAO Capacity Building Programme

- Support provided by ICAO Regional Offices and Technical Cooperation Bureau






114 States trained up to March 2015







77 States, representing around 83% international RTK, submitted an Action Plan as of March 2015

MID Environment Seminar March 2014

- 8 States from MID Region participated
- Presentations from 4 States from the region on planned updates to their Action Plans – sharing information and best practices
 - Wide range of measures being explored
 - States working to <u>quantify</u> their expected results and re-submit by June 2015





States' Action Plans - Key Achievements

- 114 States trained, 160 States contacted by phone, 77 States' Action Plans submitted.
- Substantial support and engagement by States in developing Action Plans in a short time
- Many synergies for action generated Involvement of different actors
- Improvement of the knowledge and experience acquired
- States are invited to update and submit their action plans to ICAO once every three years.





More support needed

However there is a need for:

- Further training of new State Focal Points
- Translation of material, guidance, tools, etc. in all languages
- More assistance to States


Support from States:

- Ensure retention of knowledge within the DGCAs (less HR rotation)
- Voluntary funding earmarked for the Action Plan/Assistance to States initiative











ICAO – UNDP Project with GEF financing

- Objective: To provide assistance to developing countries and Small Islands Developing States (SIDS) in reducing aviation emissions and implementation of a pilot project in Jamaica replicable in other Developing States and SIDs.
- 2 Million dollars assistance project


Conclusions

- ICAO priorities on environment are:
 - State action plans and assistance
 - Sustainable alternative fuels for aviation
 - Market-based Measures (MBMs)
 - Global aspirational goals
 - CO₂ Standard expected to be developed by 2016; and
 - work in cooperation with other UN bodies in particular in support to the UNFCCC process
- Climate change will remain the main challenge on the ICAO environmental activities in the upcoming years.








