1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Incident is defined in ICAO Annex 13 as an occurrence, other than an accident, associated with the operation of an aircraft which affects or could affect the safety of operation.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 According to ICAO iSTARS (ADREP et al.), 76 incidents were reported during the period (2010-2014). However, the majority of incidents are not categorized.

2.2 It is to be highlighted that the number of reported Serious Incidents for the period (2010-2014) reflects insufficient reporting to ICAO.

3. ACTION BY THE MEETING

3.1 The meeting is invited to:

- a) review the Incidents data;
- b) agree on the categorization;
- c) identify main root causes and contributing factors; and
- d) provide safety recommendations as appropriate.

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
