- Competency units
 - Discrete function
 - Contains competency elements
- Competency elements
 - Action
 - Triggering event
 - Terminating event
 - Defined limits
 - Observable outcome
- Performance criteria
 - Required outcome of competency elements
 - Criteria to judge if performance achieved










Competency Unit 2 — Preparing dangerous goods shipment




Competency Unit 2 Preparing Dangerous Goods Shipment




Competency Unit 3 Processing /Accepting Cargo








Competency Unit 5 Accepting Passenger and Crew Baggage








Competency Unit 6 Transporting Cargo / Baggage
