MID REGION AIM DATABASE TASK FORCE (MIDAD TF)

1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

The terms of Reference of the MIDAD TF are to:

- a) take responsibility for overall leadership, supervision, direction, and management of the MIDAD project, in coordination with the MAEP PMO/SC/Board and TCB, as appropriate;
- b) carry out necessary coordination with States for the establishment of the MID Region AIM Database (MIDAD);
- c) address all technical and operational issues related to MIDAD;
- d) address all financial, legal and institutional issues related to MIDAD, in coordination with the MAEP PMO/SC/Board, as appropriate;
- e) monitor the developments of the MIDAD Project; and
- f) provide regular progress reports to the AIM SG, MAEP SC/Board, MSG, ANSIG, MIDANPIRG and DGCA-MID, as appropriate, concerning its work programme.

2. COMPOSITION

The MIDAD TF is composed of:

- a) all MIDAD member States:
- b) other MID States which are not member of MIDAD and concerned International/Regional Organizations, as observers; and
