- 1.8 million square km ▶
- More than 250 P,D,R areas ▶
- More than 1000 over flights a day ▶
- More than 1000 domestic flights ▶
- 80 airports ▶
- 1400 military (training and ...) flights ▶
- Weekly missile tests ▶
- 50 military UAV daily ▶
- 25 military operation annually ▶

Its set before our eyes :

Airspace is a natural resource with finite capacity for which demand from all users is expanding and that there has been increased requirement on airspace to meet a fast growing aviation demand .

# The Path We Paved :

- ▶ **Establishment** of a national high-level civil military coordination body. ▶
- ▶ **Development** of a collaborative national airspace planning process , taking into consideration the needs of all airspace users and national security/defence and law enforcement requirement. ▶
- ▶ **Establishment** of communication , negotiation and priority rules and procedures for civil-military coordination . ▶
- ▶ **Development** of a framework agreement between civil and military authorities to facilitate coordination . ▶
- ▶ **Periodically** reviewing airspace needs /organization and management. ▶
