- International Organization
- Created in 1923
- 192 Member Countries

Purpose: to promote communication and exchange of information between police forces of Member Countries



Connect INTERPOL Member Countries Police to I-24/7

What is I-24/7? secure worldwide INTERPOL IT network

Purpose: to provide instant access to real-time criminal data

- 17 databases
- 4.6 billion searches each year on INTERPOL databases



For Airport Security specifically

Early check (before the passengers arrive):

Possible to compare automatically API lists with INTERPOL Stolen and Lost travel document database (80 million documents registered) and wanted persons database

Passengers check by Front Line Police Officers:

Possible to compare automatically the scanned passport with INTERPOL Stolen and Lost travel document database and wanted persons database
