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# THE REGIONAL ROADMAP TO IMPLEMENT THE GLOBAL AVIATION SECURITY PLAN IN THE EUR/NAT REGIONS

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### The EUR/NAT Regional GASeP Conference

- Conducted on 29-31 May 2018 in Lisbon, Portugal
- Established a regional roadmap as the basis for the work to be carried out by States, Organizations and Industry in the EUR/NAT regions to implement the GASeP
- Endorsed the regional roadmap and a conference declaration

# **EUR/NAT GASeP Conference Declaration**

States, Organizations and Industry underlined their commitment to the regional roadmap through the conference declaration and agreed on the following:





## **EUR/NAT GASeP Conference Declaration**

- **To recognize** that the EUR/NAT aviation security roadmap is a "living" document contributing to effective implementation of the GASeP by States and other stakeholders in the EUR/NAT regions and if and where appropriate beyond
- To reaffirm the need to enhance the effective implementation of ICAO aviation security Standards and Recommended Practices
- **To commit** to work together with the shared and common goal of achieving the five key priority outcomes of the GASeP in the entire EUR/NAT regions in the time scale set out in Appendix A to the regional roadmap







# **EUR/NAT GASeP Conference Declaration**

- To recognize that the five key priority outcomes of the GASeP provide a welcome focus whose achievement would represent a qualitative improvement in global aviation security
- To work in compliance with UN SC resolution 2309 (2016) and respective ICAO assembly resolutions under ICAO's leadership; and
- To endorse the attached EUR/NAT aviation security roadmap discussed in Lisbon.



#### **Takes into account:**

- The complex geographic situation in the EUR/NAT regions encompassing 56 diverse states
- The particularity due to the existence of several regional organizations dealing also with AVSEC
- The five key priorities outlined in the GASeP



### Forms the basis for achieving:

- Harmonized, effective and efficient implementation of the GASeP
- Coordinated and holistic implementation of Annex 17 and Annex 9 (security related) provisions
- Avoidance of duplication of efforts

#### ASPIRATIONAL GLOBAL TARGETS

- a) By 2020 80% of EUR/NAT States reach above 65% EI
- b) By 2023 90% of EUR/NAT States reach above 80% EI
- c) By 2030 100% of EUR/NAT States reach above 90% EI

#### **Key priority 1 - ENHANCE RISK AWARENESS AND RESPONSE**

#### **Actions:**

#### Promote threat and risk awareness and appropriate risk assessment methodology taking into consideration evolving and emerging threats (...), vulnerabilities and corrective security measures used to mitigate them

 Establish and ensure effective and efficient national and region wide mechanism for the exchange of information ...

#### **Projected Outcome:**

 Effective security risk assessment methodology established by states and industry

 Promotion and use of PoC network and other existing regional mechanisms for exchange of information



### **Key priority 1 - ENHANCE RISK AWARENESS AND RESPONSE Projected Outcome:**

#### **Actions:**

- Improve the quality and quantity of training on risk assessment...,including vulnerability assessment
- Review the results of quality control activities on international, regional and national level to determine prevailing deficiencies in the region
- Accumulate, keep track and share best practices to address threats ...

Appropriately trained workforce for risk

and vulnerability assessments

- Better understanding of vulnerabilities, effective risk assessment conducted. enhanced implementation of ICAO Annex 17 and 9 (security relevant) SARPS
- Consistency in best practices is developed





# Key priority 2 - DEVELOP SECURITY CULTURE & DEVELOP HUMAN CAPABILITY IN AVIATION SECURITY

#### **Actions:**

- Promote development of security awareness programmes...
- Develop and improve training material for AVSEC personnel taking into account human factor principles and risk
- Promote human factor principles in AVSEC training ...

- Enhanced security culture within organizations and general public
- Enhanced human capability and appropriately trained workforce



# Key priority 2 - DEVELOP SECURITY CULTURE & DEVELOP HUMAN CAPABILITY IN AVIATION SECURITY

#### **Actions:**

 Ensure sufficient funding for a robust, trained and motivated security workforce

• Encourage communication between all relevant stakeholders with regards to training needs, training material ...

#### **Priority Outcome:**

- Continuous improvement of work performance and establishment of a conducive work environment to avoid turnover and build competency
- Optimal use of recourses, improvement of training quality...





# Key priority 3 - IMPROVE TECHNOLOGICAL RESOURSES AND FOSTER INNOVATION

#### **Actions:**

- Promote innovation and use of efficient technologies...as well as the use of nontechnical innovative methods...
- Promote the active use of AVSECPaedia as the relevant platform for exchange of information on technology, innovation, testing and certification...

- Enhanced security via use of most effective technology and innovative techniques...
- Enhanced understanding and effectiveness of security processes throughout the region





# Key priority 3 - IMPROVE TECHNOLOGICAL RESOURSES AND FOSTER INNOVATION

#### **Actions:**

 Encourage and assist states and industry in the provision of innovative technology and techniques to states in need and support funding

#### **Projected Outcome:**

 Enhanced screening and other security equipment as well as innovative techniques used throughout the region



#### **Key priority 4 - IMPROVE OVERSIGHT AND QUALITY ASSURANCE**

#### **Actions:**

- Analyze regional USAP-CMA results and national quality control data to identify compliance issues
- Promote the exchange of information on innovative and efficient state oversight methods...

- Setting of realistic targets for effective implementation of ICAO Annex 17 and Annex 9 (security relevant) requirements
- Continuous improvement of effective implementation of critical elements of a states oversight system and ICAO Annex 17 and 9 (security relevant) provisions, national and regional legislation





#### **Key priority 4 - IMPROVE OVERSIGHT AND QUALITY ASSURANCE**

#### **Actions:**

- Establish framework for rectification of gaps and deficiencies... and immediate response measures ...
- Develop and maintain guidance material and provide relevant training pertinent to quality control activities
- Improve capability and strengthen authority of national AVSEC inspectors...

- Timely rectification of deficiencies and improved compliance with all requirements...
- Enhanced States' and industry capacity to conduct quality control activities
- Enhanced national aviation security oversight systems in the region ...





#### **Key priority 5 – INCREASE COOPERATION ANSD SUPPORT**

#### **Actions:**

- Encourage implementation of UNSCR 2309 (2016), GASeP objectives, regional roadmap...
- Promote coordinated assistance and capacity building activities among all relevant stakeholders
- Work towards a coordinated manner in providing assistance and capacity building activities, including strengthening of States' oversight capabilities to States in need

- Increased awareness of UNSCR 2309 (2016), higher priority for AVSEC within states
- Enhanced communication and coordination on capacity development to avoid duplication of efforts...
- Region wide continuous improvement of implementation of critical elements of state's oversight system and compliance with the provisions of Annex 17 and Annex 9 (security related) SARPs, national and regional legislation, less duplication, complementary capacity building



#### **SUMMARY:**

- Coordinated approach under the auspices of ICAO
- Commitment by all entities to implement the regional roadmap
- Cooperation between all entities
- Commitment by all entities to avoid duplication of efforts
