



- National SAR plan incorporating both Aeronautical and Maritime SAR






RESCUE COORDINATION CENTRE (RCC)

OJT training is conducted for all SAR SMCs before deployment in RCC



SAR OPERATIONS: WORKING WITH AGENCIES

SAR POINTS OF CONTACT(SPOCs)

- Sensitization meetings each agency
- Each agency has a SAR point of Contact
- Agency SPOCs with sufficient latitude to
- Make decisions when RCC calls on them



SAR OPERATIONS: WORKING WITH AGENCIES

Each agency has provided RCC with details on:-

- Numbers of qualified SAR Personnel and their distribution
- Suitable SAR assets owned by agencies and their availability
- Contacts for their operations offices and SPOCs

SAR OPERATIONS:SAR STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES


The SAR SOP developed in close coordination with Agencies

- Hard and soft copies distributed to all agencies with and training on agencies role conducted by agency.

Nairobi RCC collecting information within the Nairobi SRR

Exact location(coordinates)

- State of wreckage(intact or broken)
- Colour of the wreckage
