




Establishment

- SAR organization in Ghana is established by an Act of Parliament, Ghana Civil Aviation Act, 2004 (Act 678)
- Regulated by Ghana Civil Aviation Directives, Part 37
 (Aeronautical Search & Rescue)

Accra Search & Rescue Region



Coordination with Adjacent FIRs

- Accra Rescue Coordination Centre has signed SAR Agreements with the ff adjacent FIRs:
 - a) Lome
 - b) Cotonou
 - c) Lagos
 - d) Ouagadogou
 - e) Abidjan (in progress)
 - f) Luanda (pending)
 - g) Brazaville (pending)

SAR Arrangements/Agreements with the National Agencies

- Ghana Armed Forces(Navy, Airforce, Army)
- Ghana Ports and Harbours Authority
- Ghana Police Service
- NADMO Ghana
- Ghana National Fire Service
- Ghana Health Service
- Ghana Immigration Service
- Ghana Maritime Authority
- Ghana Ports and Harbour Authority
- Ghana Airports Company Limited (GACL)
- Ghana Ministry of Defence
- Ghana National Ambulance Service
- Private Agencies (Fishermen, Helicopter Companies, etc)

Communication with SAR Agencies

- Communication exists with the ff Units:
 - Air Traffic Services
 - Military
 - Rescue and Emergency Services
 - Meteorological Service
 - Aeronautical Telecommunication
 - NOTAM Office
 - Airport Operations, and
 - Others

Cooperation b/n Aeronautical and Maritime Search & Rescue

- Not a joint RCC
- Agreement between Aeronautical and Maritime Agencies (High Level)
- Operational Agreement between Aeronautical and Maritime RCCs
- Direct communication between MRCC and ARCC
- Joint SAREX between MRCC and ARCC
- Liaison visits between ARCC and MRCC personnel

Emergency Response Plan (ERP) for Regional Airports in Ghana

- The RCC is responsible for accidents beyond eight (8) Nm from the Airport
- The RCC has established ERPs for five (5)
 Regional Airports in collaboration with relevant SRUs
- The ERP is activated in Emergency

Overview of SAR operation in Ghana - Helicopter crash in the sea

- An off-shore helicopter crash in May 2014
- Ghana Airforce, Takoradi, informs RCC in Accra
- RCC coordinated with Takoradi Airforce to establish EOC at the Airforce Base
- The EOC was transferred from Airforce Base to Naval Base to continue with the maritime search (MRCC)
- Inadequate assets of the Maritime team required external support (appropriately equipped Vessels, Divers, etc)

Overview of SAR OPS Cont'd

- Devastated Helicopter rescued from the sea bed after 19 days of search operation
- Services of a ship, Seabed Worker was employed in the search operation
- Casualties?Four (4) deaths, Four (4) survivors.


SAR Operations in pictures











Challenges (RCC)

- Agreements with some neighbouring States and RCC
- Robust National SAR Plan and Operating Procedures
- Establishment and functioning of the National SAR Committee
- Funding SAR organization, establishment and operation
- Inadequate office space with modern SAR facilities for the RCC
- Inadequate staff strength for the RCC & RSCs
- Adequate Training
