

Consists of 4 levels based on the average percentage of new cases to tests, in addition to the level of occupancy in intensive care unit.

**View Red Level Guidelines**


About The Alert System

- The medical team noted that some dates may be designated by the National Medical Taskforce at higher alert levels if deemed necessary to the health and safety of all.
- Moving from a higher alert level to a lower one would require staying at the same level for a period of no less than a week.
- Moving up from a lower alert level to a higher one can be immediate.
- For example, it would be possible to directly move from the green to the red level without going through the yellow and orange levels if the data indicated the need to.
- The thresholds set for each alert level is subject to change according to data and developments
