- Egypt has established a national plan to address the spread of covid 19 with coordination of all stakeholders esp the aviation sector as it plays a vital role in taking preventive action to reduce the risk of spread.
- Ministry of Civil Aviation is communicating with Ministry of Public Health and Quarantine Authority at airports and is following the recommendations and periodic instructions issued by Ministry of Health and CART recommendations from ICAO and making sure that all airlines are implementing those instructions.

Steps done:

Putting instructions for implementing precautions and preventive procedures:

- Hygiene.
- Availability of hand sanitizers.
- Face masking all through the journey.
- Physical distancing.
- Dealing with airplane waste as dangerous waste.
- Providing medical important tools for relevant parties.
- Those precautions are for cabinet crew, airlines, airports, workers, and passengers.



Direct and indirect awareness:

- Training of crew on precautions and how to deal with a suspected cases based on ICAO and WHO instructions
- Training of staff of airports and ground companies and cargo on how to follow precautions
- Give passengers clear information about covid 19 spread and symptoms and instructions to follow the precautions needed, forms needed to fulfill and testing for covid 19 according to the current situation

Follow up process

civil aviation authority make continuous follow up for

quarantine work

temp screening

declaration and contact forms

disinfection process and all public health and CART recommendations

Evaluation and control process by continuous evaluation of implementation issued by national and international organizations and modulate the precautions according to it's applicability and the change at the global situation.
