SHARING SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

(Presented by the Secretariat)

SUMMARY

This paper presents the analysis of the Questionnaire on Establishing a Platform for Sharing Safety Recommendations for review and process by the MENA ARCM/2 meeting

Action by the meeting is at paragraph 3.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The RSC/6 meeting agreed to form a Safety Enhancement Initiative (SEI) to be considered by RASG-MID to enhance sharing of safety recommendations and to establish a regional database, which would be beneficial for addressing the Focus Areas and Emerging Risks in the MID-Region.

1.2 A working paper (WP/5) was presented by United Arab Emirates to the AIIG/1 virtual meeting that was held from 7 to 9 September 2021 including the draft Questionnaire on Establishing a Platform for Sharing Safety Recommendations. The meeting discussed and agreed to present it to the RASG-MID/9 for endorsement.

1.3 The RASG-MID/9 supported the establishment of a repository for MENA ARCM Member States to allow sharing the analysis of their safety recommendations and endorsed the following Conclusion:

***RASG-MID CONCLUSION 9/7: QUESTIONNAIRE ON ESTABLISHING A
PLATFORM FOR SHARING SAFETY
RECOMMENDATIONS***

*That, the questionnaire on establishing a platform for sharing safety information among MENA ARCM member States at **Appendix 4.6A** be used for the conduct of the survey on the subject.*

The meeting may wish to note that Fourteen (14) States signed the MENA ARCM MoU at **Appendix A** during the Future Aviation Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, 9-11 May 2022 namely Djibouti, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Palestine, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, UAE, and Yemen.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The Questionnaire on Establishing a Platform for Sharing Safety Recommendations at **Appendix B** was sent to the MENA ARCM member States through State Letter Ref.: ME 4- 22/113 dated 6 June 2022. Replies were received at **Appendix C** from nine (9) States (Djibouti, Iran, Jordan, Morocco, Oman, Palestine, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, and UAE).

2.2 The analysis of the replies as indicated below:

1. Eight (8) States have in place regulations relevant to monitoring safety recommendations implementation. One State has not regulations in place.
2. Six (6) State have in place a guidance and system for how to formulate and address the safety recommendation and monitor its implementation: Three States have not guidance in place.
3. Eight (8) State interested in sharing Final Reports of accidents and serious incidents investigations with other MENA States. One States is not interested in sharing Final Reports.
 - State preferred medium for sharing the Report: Four States: Email; Three States: Website and Email; and two States: Website.
4. Most of States have safety recommendations issued by the State comprise of all components. Some of states the recommended risk mitigation actions.
5. Eight (8) States interested in sharing information about safety recommendations. One State is not interested.
 - Six States prefer to share the safety recommendations as they are stated in the report and two revised to another format.
 - State's preferred medium for sharing the safety recommendation: five States: Email; two States: E-form in the website, and two State: other.
6. Frequency of sharing: five States: Semi-annually; two States: Monthly; One State: Annually; and one State: Quarterly
7. Safety recommendations are linked to the State Safety Program: Three States with linked safety recommendations to the SSP; four State did not provide any information, and one State with no SSP implementation in place,
8. Eight (8) confirmed to conduct periodic meetings to review the progress of safety recommendations with other States:

2.3 The MENA ARCM/2 meeting is expected to agree on the way forward to move towards the establishment of Platform for Sharing Safety Recommendations.

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
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

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
