
Collaborative Decision Making (ACDM) Implementation

5. Passport, VISA and customs formalities

- **5.1 Very Important**: Normally upon having any delegations or participants arriving at Doha on an official visit to meet with the officials of QCAA or to participate at any event organized by QCAA so it is recommended **to have their visas issued by QCAA**, therefore we kindly request to provide us with a list of all the participants' details along with clear passports copies to **facilitate the Visa process as deemed necessary** by 21st of October 2023.
- 5.2 For entry into the Qatar, all visitors must hold a passport valid for at least 6 months or other valid travel documents. To check whether you are required to obtain a visa to enter Qatar as well as the customs formalities, please visit the website: https://hukoomi.gov.qa/en/article/visas
- 5.3 Airport Car Rental Service
 - a) Airport car rental service is available near exit of the terminal.
 - b) Car/taxis are also available on the side of the terminal building.
 - c) Metro is also available.

6. Other Useful Information

6.1 Internet Broadband and wireless internet services are available in all major hotels. Free wireless internet is also available in some shopping centers and public buildings in the city.

6.2 Language

Arabic is the national mother tongue, is the national language in Qatar. However, the locals can also speak in English.

6.3 Money Exchange

There are money exchange companies and commercial banks both in arrival and departure at Hamad International Airport, where you can exchange your money. There are ATMs available in the malls, hotel, Metro.

The Qatar Riyal (QAR) is the local currency used. Current exchange rate is 1 USD equivalent to 3.6 QAR. Credit cards such as American Express, Visa, and Mastercard are acceptable by the hotels and all the stores in the shopping malls.

6.4 Sim Card

Sim Cards and sim card top-up or refills are available in the arrival passenger lounge and in all

the malls.

Qatar country code is +974. The international dialing codes and dialing format to call landline in Qatar is: (Country Code) + Recipient's Number.

The international dialing codes and dialing format to call mobile number in Qatar is: (Country Code) + Digits Cellular Number.

To make an international call to landline phone number from Qatar, the dialing format should be: 00 - Country Code - Area Code - Landline phone number without the 0 at the beginning of the number.

To make a call or send a text message internationally from Qatar, the dialing format should be: 00 - Country Code - Mobile Phone Number excluding the 0 at the beginning of the number

6.5 Time Difference:

Qatar is 3 hours ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC +3).

6.6 Weather

The weather in November usually sits at around 30- 32 Degrees $^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and 20-24 Degrees $^{\circ}$ C in the evening.

6.7 Electric Plug and Socket

Qatar operates power plug sockets of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the frequency is 50 Hz We suggest you bring a universal travel adapter plug to charge your laptop and mobile electronic devices.

1 National Museum of Qatar

The National Museum of Qatar gives voice to Qatar's unique history and its people from the earliest of times to the present day.
