#### BULLETIN

#### 1. LOCATION

1.1 The General Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) of the United Arab Emirates is organizing an international event under the title "The Future Aviation Safety and Aircraft Accident Investigation Symposium", in cooperation with ICAO and coordination with ICAO MID Office. The Symposium will be held in Dubai, Le Méridien Dubai Hotel & Conference Centre, from 3 to 4 May 2023

#### 2. SCHEDULE OF THE EVENTS

- 2.1 The opening session of the Symposium will be held at **09:00** hours on Wednesday, 3 May 2023.
- 2.2 The schedule and order of the day will be announced at the opening session.
- 2.3 The events will be conducted in English.

# 3. REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS

3.1 A Welcome Desk will be located at the entrance of the designated meeting room, between **08:00** and **09:30** hours on the opening day of the events. A Welcome Team will be available to answer questions and issue participants with a meeting Identification Badge, which you are requested to wear during the meeting.

## 4. DOCUMENTATION

4.1 Please note that no documentation will be available in hard copy format. However, documentation related to the event will be available on the ICAO MID Regional Office website.

# 5. HOTEL RESERVATIONS

- 5.1 Participants will need to arrange their own hotel and travel reservations.

- 5.3 Participants are requested to ensure that their return airline booking is confirmed.

#### 6. TRANSPORTATION

- 6.1 Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from/to the airport and from/to the event's venue.
- Dubai International Airport taxi is available 24 hours a day and the taxi ranks can be found directly outside each of the terminal building arrival areas. You will find the drivers have good knowledge of the tourist attractions, hotels, and other major locations in Dubai. All airport's taxi drivers also command more than one language. The taxi at Dubai International Airport is metered and the charge is calculated according to the distance recorded.

#### 7. INSURANCE

7.1 Participants are advised to have insurance coverage for any unexpected contingency including transport hazards (taxi, buses, rented cars, etc.) and Medical Coverage.

## 8. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

8.1 Vaccinated travelers to the UAE are not required to present a negative result of RT-PCR test for COVID-19 at the airport of departure. However, those who are not vaccinated must either present a valid, negative result of an RT-PCR test conducted within 48 hours before arrival or a recovery certificate (containing a QR code) from COVID-19 issued within 30 days before departure, if they were infected with the virus.

#### 9. SOME USEFUL TRAVEL INFORMATION PASSPORT/VISA

- 9.1 All foreign nationals entering the United Arab Emirates must possess a passport which is valid for a minimum of 6 months from the date of entry.
- 9.2 Visas, if required, should be obtained from the original country. The GCAA event's Focal Point identified in paragraph 13 may assist in arranging invitation letters if needed. Participants should obtain updated information on entry requirements by accessing the UAE Government web page <a href="https://government.ae/en/information-and-services/visa-and-emirates-id">https://government.ae/en/information-and-services/visa-and-emirates-id</a>.
- 9.3 Common documents requirement for visa application: Clear passport copy, white background clear photo, letter from employer/sponsor company in Arabic, home country ID for Pakistan, Iraq, Iran and Afghanistan. Please send all documents in JPEG format.

# **CUSTOMS**

- 9.4 Each traveler is permitted to bring the following with them into the UAE:
  - 4 liters of alcohol or one (1) carton / 24 cans of beer
  - AED 2,000 worth of cigarettes or 400 sticks of cigarettes
  - AED 3,000 worth of cigars
  - 2 kilograms of tobacco
  - AED 3,000 worth of gifts, including perfume

### 10. CURRENCY, CREDIT CARDS AND BANKING SERVICES

10.1 The unit of currency in UAE is Dirhams (AED) with notes of 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1000 and coins of Fils 10, 25, 50 and 1 Dirham. The current rates of exchange for the major currencies are as follows:

USD 1= 3.673 AED EUR 1= 3.895 AED GBP 1= 4.617 AED

- All passengers travelling through Dubai International Airport carrying AED100, 000 or more or a sum of foreign currency of the same value are required to inform the customs personnel about the cash they have and they should also inform them about the precious items, such as gold and jewelry, they may have through their exit from the designated gates of such cases.
- 10.3 International credit cards, such as American Express, Visa, Master Card, etc., are usually accepted at most hotels, department stores and restaurants.
- 10.4 Foreign currency exchanges and ATMs are readily accessible at the airport and major shopping destinations.
- 10.5 Commercial banks, currency exchanges and major foreign currencies and branch networks stay open from 08:00 am to 04:00 pm for customers, six days a week, from Monday to Saturday, with Sunday being the day of closure, with a few exceptions. On Fridays, the aforementioned financial institutions stay open from 08:00 am and close at 12:00 pm to observe the Friday prayer.

## 11. OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION DRINKING WATER

11.1 Only bottled water.

#### 12. WEATHER CONDITIONS

12.1 The mean daily minimum and maximum temperatures for the month of May in the internal regions of the country are expected to be between 32°C and 37°C with 11 hours of sunshine a day. You may also wish to check the weather forecasting prior to travel.
