

Aviation's global employment and GDP impact






Aviation supports tourism

Projected growth in tourism facilitated by aviation, contribution to global GDP, 2018-2038




Economic Impact of Aviation in Middle East

Preamble

THEREFORE, the undersigned governments having agreed on certain principles and arrangements in order that <u>international civil</u> <u>aviation may be developed in a safe and orderly manner and that international air transport services may be establish on the basis of equality of opportunity and operated soundly and economically</u>

Article 44

d) Meet the needs of the peoples of the world for safe, regular, efficient and economical air transport.
