


Overflying Charges

An air navigation fees for aircraft crossing the airspace of Jordan is charged at the rate of one dinar per ton for the maximum take-off weight for the aircraft according to the aircraft's noise certificate.

Landing charges at Queen Alia International Airport

Landing charges at Queen Alia International Airport are adjusted every three years according to the Inflation Rate as peer the International agreement signed between the government as a granter and the operator of queen alia int. airport "AIG" The Investor.

It is calculated based on the weight of the aircraft and divided into segments:


First 25 Ton	2.563 JD
Second 75 Ton	3.845 JD
Over 100 ton	4.357 JD

ATC Charges

A fee of 10% of the scheduled landing fee is collected at Jordanian airports in exchange for air traffic control services, provided that the fee is not less than 30 Jordanian dinars for each flight.




Arrival and Departure movements




ITAC Billing System For Issuing Invoices
