

Three Key Actions

1

Develop enhanced provisions for Urban Air Mobility

2

Facilitate access by Remotely Piloted Aircraft to non-segregated airspace while preserving safety and capacity for existing users

3

Develop enhanced provisions for UTM and UAS

Ensure ICAO's monitoring functions remain fit for purpose

Engage with States at the highest level to accept activities as planned, and promptly implement and report corrective actions







The ICAO 2026-2028 Business Plan
