

## **INTRODUCTION**



#### CHALLENGES IN AERODROME CERTIFICATION




#### **Preparation (Pre – Certification)**

- Identification and appointment of a competent official to act as single point of contact (SPOC) for initiating advance coordination with the regulator/certifying agency.
- Creation of dedicated task force with a composition of members from respective functions (Aerodrome Standards & Planning, Operations, Engineering, ARFF, Safety, Security, ATC, etc.)
- Data compilation, verification and validation of the collected data.
- Development of Aerodrome Manual and other associated support manuals and documents (SMS Manual, Emergency Plan, Disabled Aircraft Removal Plan, SOPs, Wildlife Hazard Management Plan, Obstacle Controls, etc.)
- Ensuring the quality of the final document by an **expert panel to verify** all compliances are in place (before formal submission to regulator)

ARFF: Airport Rescue & Fire Fighting
ATC - Air Traffic Controller



#### CHALLENGES IN AERODROME CERTIFICATION



#### Certification

- The real time coordination to facilitate on-site inspection and audit.
- Demonstrating compliance through various simulated scenarios as expected by the inspectors, with specific emphasize full scale emergency mock drills and other such critical exercises.
- The stringent timeline to address and resolve observations raised by the inspectors during the audit
- Having all relevant data and justification including aeronautical studies or simulation reports in case of any noncompliance/exemptions expected to be considered by the regulator.

#### CHALLENGES IN AERODROME CERTIFICATION



#### **Demonstration of Continued Compliance (Post-certification)**

- Availability of dedicated teams to ensure regular checks and corrective actions and a process to ensure the quality of such actions.
- Continuous provision of budget and resources to meet corrective actions as and when required
- Establishment of a process to proactively identify and address any changes introduced into the system which are beyond the scope of the current certification terms of reference (Management of Change process)

#### **CHALLENGES**


- 1. Correct composition
- 2. Commitment from stakeholders to attend meeting consistently
- Reluctance to share incident or accidents





#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Core members: Airport, ATC & Pilot.
   Co-opted: Aerodrome & Airline maintenance rep.
- 2. Established planner with advance notification
- 3. Ensure non-disclosure clause available in the TOR

- Consistent engagement with regulator
- Follow-up on task for preparation & continued compliance.
