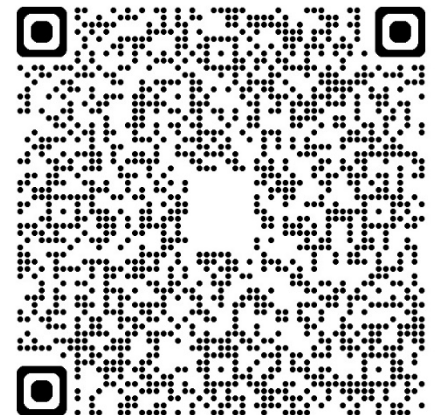
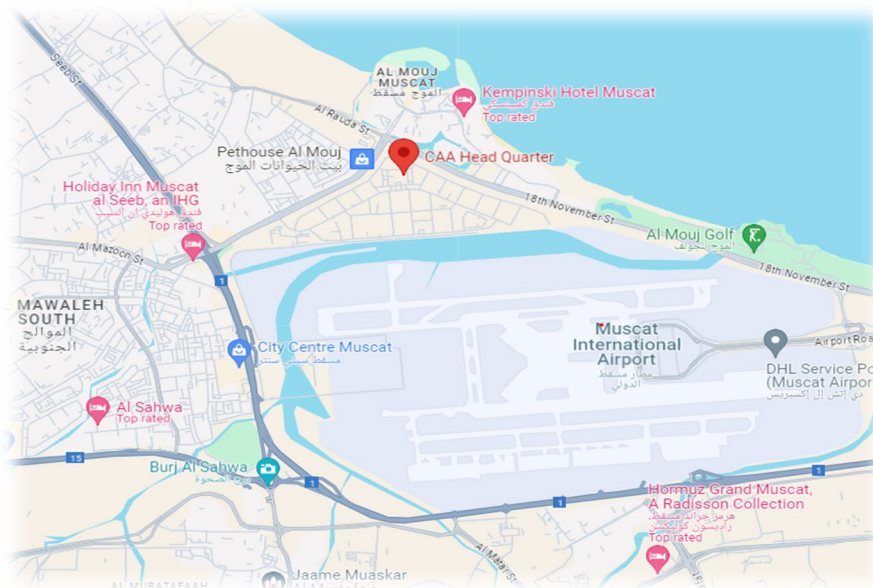

## **5. Passport, VISA and customs formalities**

5.1 All foreign nationals entering the Sultanate of Oman must possess valid passports or other valid documents for travel. Documents with less than six months to run before expiry are not acceptable.

5.2 It is mandatory for all non GCC participants to obtain visas from the Sultanate of Oman Embassy or Consulate in their country prior to their departure for Muscat. Participants that require assistance for their entry visa **need to directly contact Oman Focal Point Mr. Yousuf Mohammed Al-Aufi email:** [y.alaufi@caa.gov.om](mailto:y.alaufi@caa.gov.om) / Mobile No: **+968 92343477** by submitting the following items:

- Copy of the Current Valid Passport
- Copy of the Personnel ID Photo with white background

5.3 The following items may be brought into the Sultanate of Oman duty free:

- Personal effects, such as necessary clothing
- 200 cigarettes or 250 gr. of cigars or tobacco
- Perfume for personal use.

5.4 Additional quantities of the above items may also be purchased at Muscat International Airport duty free arrival shops before clearing customs. Non-Muslims may purchase reasonable quantities of alcoholic drinks at this outlet.

## **6. Other Useful Information**

### **Transportation**

- 6.1 Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from the airport to the city and return.
- 6.2 Taxis are available from Muscat International Airport to all destinations in Muscat or other cities, from the taxi area just outside the main terminal building. The taxi fare from the airport start at 1.500 OMR and charged 250 Baisa for every kilometer.
- 6.3 Car rental agencies are located at the arrival hall of the airport terminal building.

### **Insurance**

Participants are advised to have insurance coverage for any unexpected contingency including **Money**.

### **Exchange**

- 6.4 There are no restrictions on import of foreign currency.
- 6.5 International Credit Cards, such as American Express, Diners Club, Visa, Master Card, Carte Blanche, etc. are usually accepted at most hotels, department stores and restaurants.
- 6.6 All commercial banks exchange major foreign currencies and are open 0800-1400 hours Sundays through Thursdays. There are also plenty of foreign exchange houses who do accept foreign currency. There are plenty of ATM machines all over Oman which are strategically located.
- 6.7 transport hazards (taxi, buses, rented cars etc.) and Medical Coverage.

### **Shopping**

- 6.8 Be prepared to bargain in small shops, sidewalk vendors etc. In large stores, however, the prices are fixed.

### **Tap Water**

- 6.9 It is recommended that all visitors drink only bottled water/beverages, however, tap water is safe for drinking.

### **Language**

- 6.10 Arabic is the national mother tongue, is the national language in Oman. However, the locals can also speak in English.

### **Sim Card**

- 6.11 Mobile sim Cards are available at the Service providers outlets at the airport arrival hall and all major commercial centers.

### **Time Difference:**

- 6.12 Oman is 4 hours ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC +4).

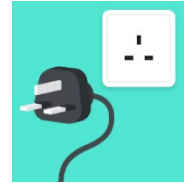
### Weather

6.13 The main daily maximum and minimum temperatures for the month of September are between 40°C by day and drop down to 28°C during the nights.

### Electric Plug and Socket

6.14 Oman operates power plug sockets of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. We suggest you bring a universal travel adapter plug to charge your laptop and mobile electronic devices.
