

Useful Travel Information

- <u>Passports</u>: All foreign nationals entering Egypt must possess valid passports or other valid documents for travel.
- <u>Visa</u>: It is mandatory that all participants obtain official entry visa from the Egyptian Embassy or Consulate in their country prior to their departure to Egypt.
- <u>Customs</u>: The following items may be brought from Egypt duty free shop:
 - 200 cigarettes or 250 gr. of cigars or tobacco.
 - 1 liter alcoholic beverages.
 - Perfume for personal use.
- <u>Currency</u>: The unit of currency of Egypt is the Egyptian Pound (L.E.), it has a
 denominations of 200, 100, 50, 20, 10, 5 and 1(L.E.).
- <u>Exchange rates:</u> for the latest exchange rates kindly visit (http://www.cbe.org.eg/).
- <u>Banking Services</u>: All commercial banks exchange major foreign currencies and are open from <u>08:30</u> to <u>14:00</u> hours, Sundays through Thursdays.
- <u>Credit Cards</u>: International Credit Cards, such as American Express,
 Diners Club, Visa, Master Card, Carte Blanche, etc. are usually accepted
 at most hotels, department stores and restaurants.
