## REPORT ON AGENDA ITEM 1: REVIEW STATUS OF CONCLUSIONS AND DECISIONS FROM MID RVSM TF/2 MEETING

- 1.1 Under this agenda item the meeting reviewed the conclusions and decisions emanating from the MID RVSM TF/2 meeting and the follow-up action which has been taken is at **Appendix 1A** to the report on this agenda item.
- 1.2 Regarding follow-up action on conclusion 2/5 related to the Revised ATS Route Structure Asia to Middle East/Europe, South of the Himalayas (EMARSSH), the meeting was of the view that pursuant to EMARSSH/3 Decision 5/6, the route network proposed by the EMARSSH meeting be discussed at the fifth meeting of the ATS/AIS/SAR Sub-Group to be held in Cairo, Egypt from 30 September to 4 October 2001 for its eventual inclusion in the MID Basic ANP Document.
- 1.3 As a follow-up to RVSM/TF2 meeting conclusion 2/10, the meeting noted with appreciation that almost all States in the Region have nominated an RVSM Programme Manager who would be responsible for ensuring that the proper mechanism be put in place for the safe implementation of RVSM and would also act as the focal point contact person within the organization. To this effect, the updated list of RVSM Programme Managers for the MID Region is indicated at **Appendix 1B** to the report on this agenda item.
