

• Enhancing pandemic preparedness in civil aviation has been a core focus of CAPSCA's work through 2023—2025. ICAO has outlined a multi-phase pandemic response strategy for aviation, moving from the emergency phase into resilience-building for the future.

A major lesson from COVID-19 is the need for riskbased, harmonized approaches rather than ad-hoc travel bans. Accordingly, CAPSCA encourages States to adopt a data-driven approach to health measures: perform regular risk assessments using comparable indicators, consult public health authorities, and only impose travel restrictions if clearly warranted by risk levels.

 One concrete strategy has been to formalize Public Health Emergency contingency planning at all levels of aviation. CAPSCA now urges every State to establish a National Public Aviation Health **Emergency** Preparedness Plan, as well as specific Airport-level Public Health Emergency Plans for all designated international airports.

• Multi-sector coordination is another pillar of the strategy. CAPSCA recognizes that managing communicable disease threat at an airport is a joint responsibility: primarily the public health authorities and airport operators at the point of entry must work hand-in-hand

• Technology and innovation are being leveraged to support pandemic response in aviation as well. CAPSCA forums have explored the use of digital platforms for health information, such as systems for verifying passengers' test/vaccination certificates or sharing health declarations electronically. The idea of a globally interoperable digital health certificate was backed by industry partners during CAPSCA meetings

CAPSCA Outcomes

 A dedicated session on public health preparedness was held during the ICAO Facilitation Conference 2025 (FALC 2025) in Doha. This session (Session 12 of the conference) focused on "Maintaining Health and Sustaining Safe International Air Transport during Public Health Emergencies of International Concern."

CAPSCA Outcomes

- FALC 2025 session 12 addressed:
 - Progress in CAPSCA implementation globally
 - New tools and policy documents under development (e.g., PANS-Health procedures)
 - Examples of national public health preparedness plans in civil aviation
 - Coordination between civil aviation and health authorities at national and airport levels
- The conference concluded with the adoption of the **Doha Declaration**, which formally included commitments aligning with CAPSCA's goals, such as requiring all States to develop National Aviation Public Health Emergency Preparedness Plans.

Updates

• CAPSCA Programme Coverage

• 85% of ICAO Member States now participate in CAPSCA — the highest engagement level to date.

• Public Health Session with CAPSCA Leadership

• ICAO and WHO jointly hosted a high-level panel, with updates from ICAO's Chief of Aviation Medicine and national CAPSCA representatives.

• Development of New Guidance: PANS-Health

• ICAO is developing "PANS-Health" (Procedures for Air Navigation Services – Health) to standardize global health emergency procedures across aviation operations.





• Doha Declaration Commitments

- States committed to:
 - Developing national aviation pandemic
 preparedness plans
 - Strengthening cross-sector collaboration with health authorities
 - Implementing WHO International Health Regulations
 (2005) in aviation contexts

Recent and Emerging Threats Cited

• Recent outbreaks (e.g., Marburg, mpox, Lassa fever) were referenced to emphasize the continuing importance of CAPSCA beyond COVID-19.

Implementation Focus Going Forward

• ICAO leadership emphasized transitioning from "planning to implementation," ensuring States execute CAPSCA guidelines and are audit-ready.
