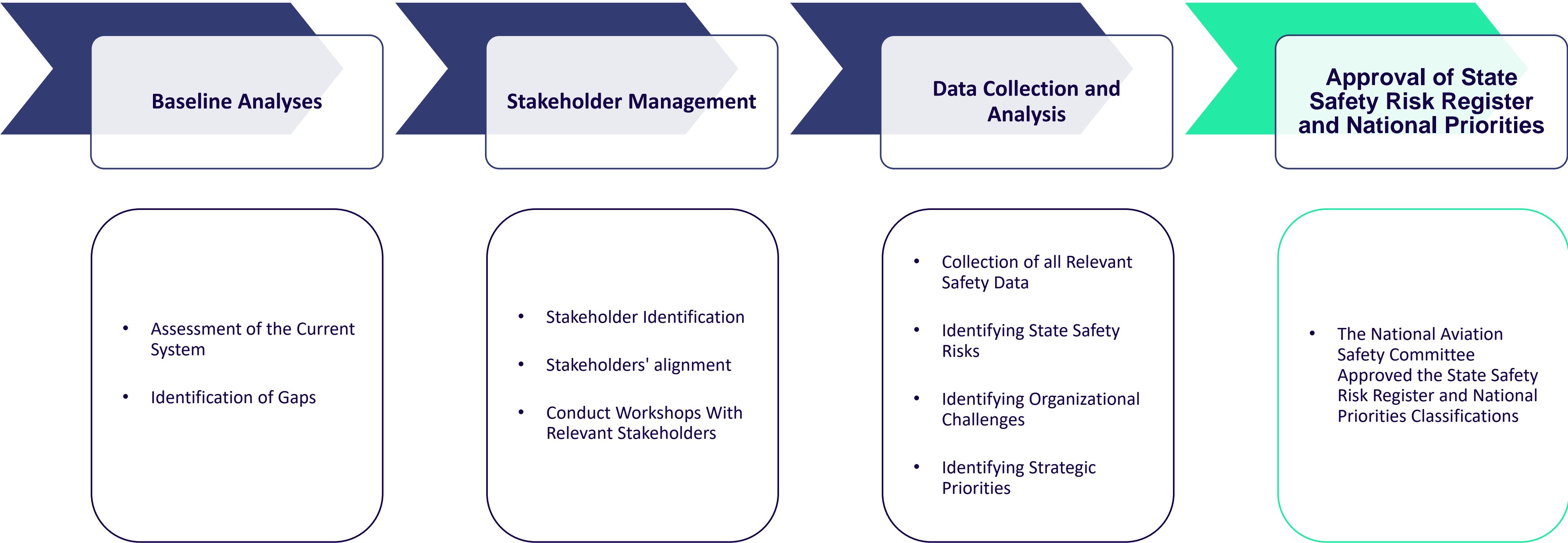

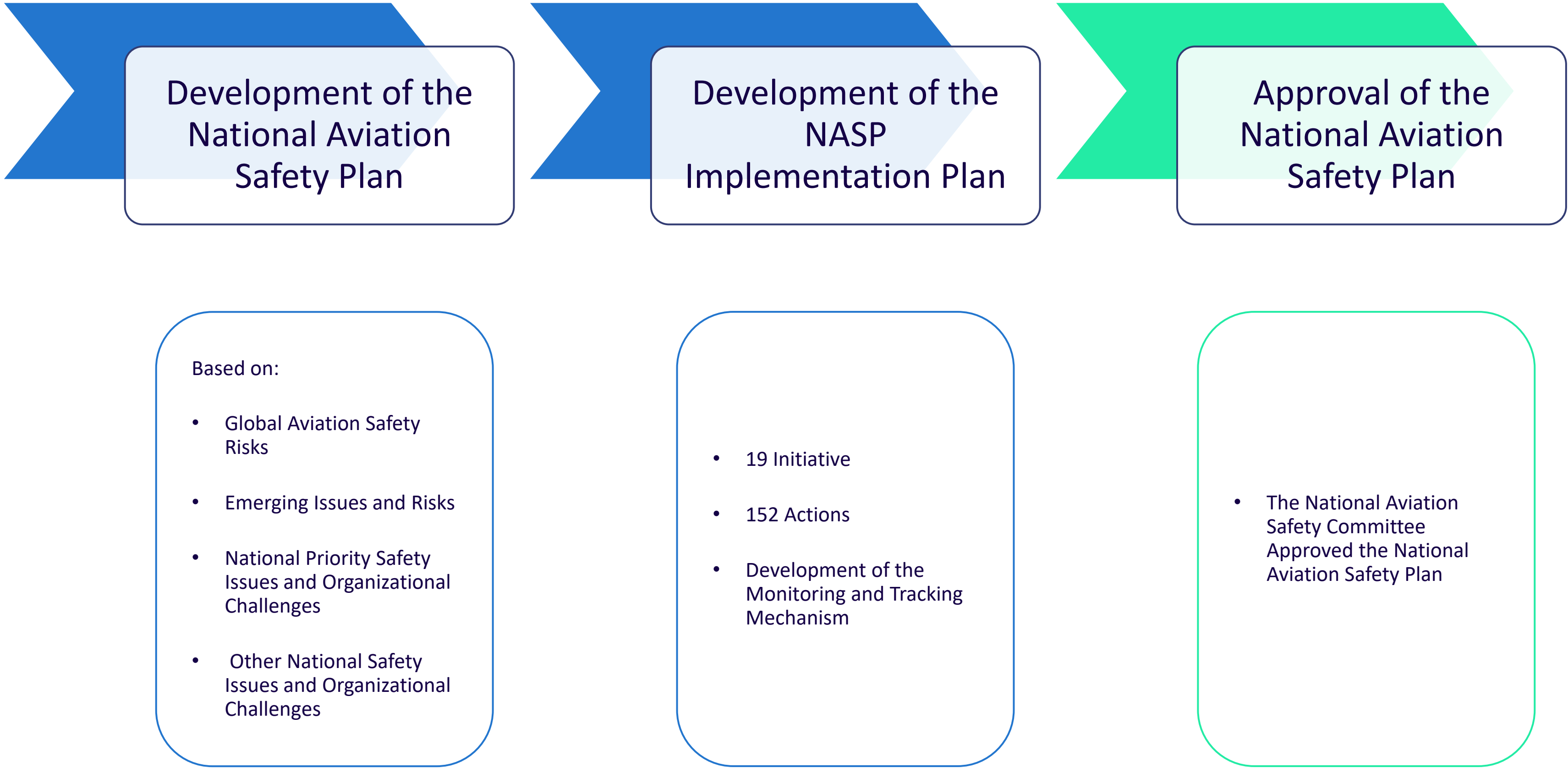

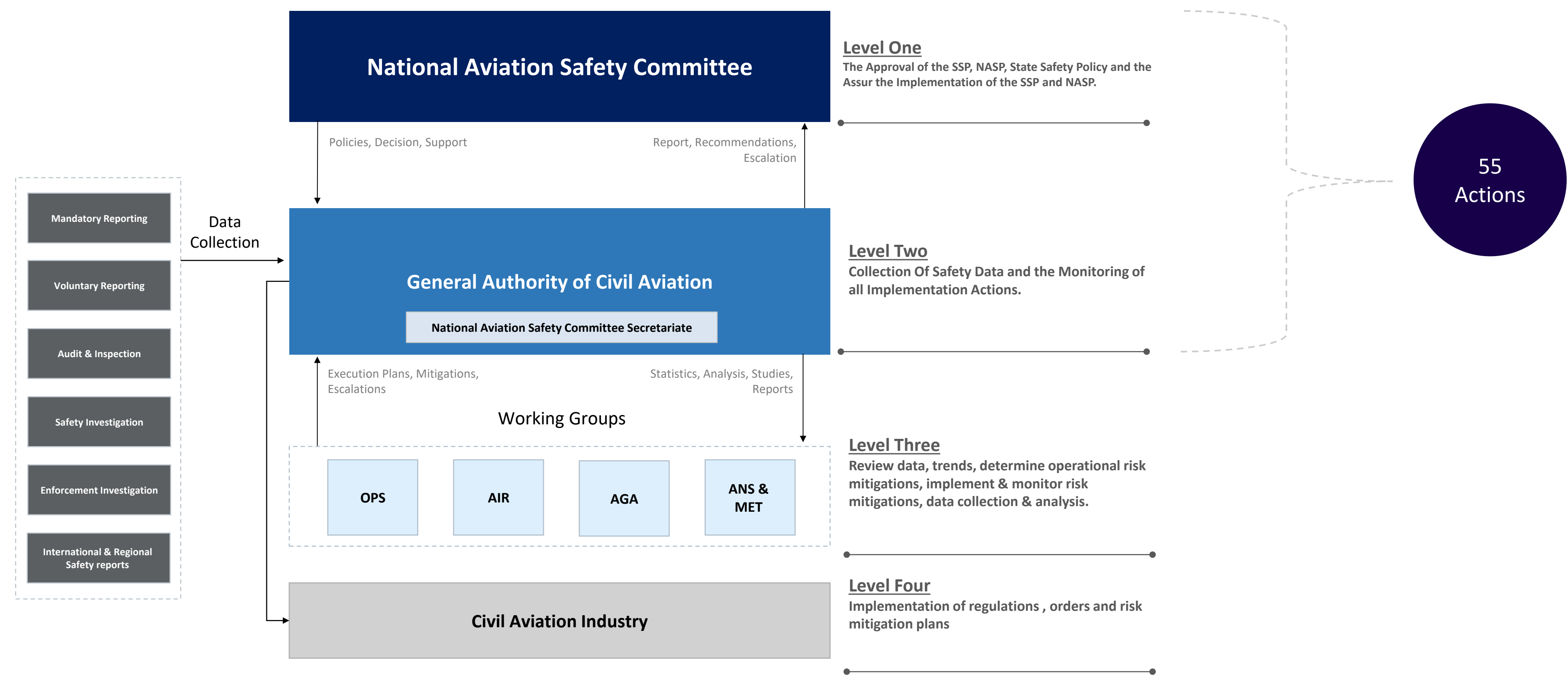

Integration with the State Safety Program (SSP) Governance Structure

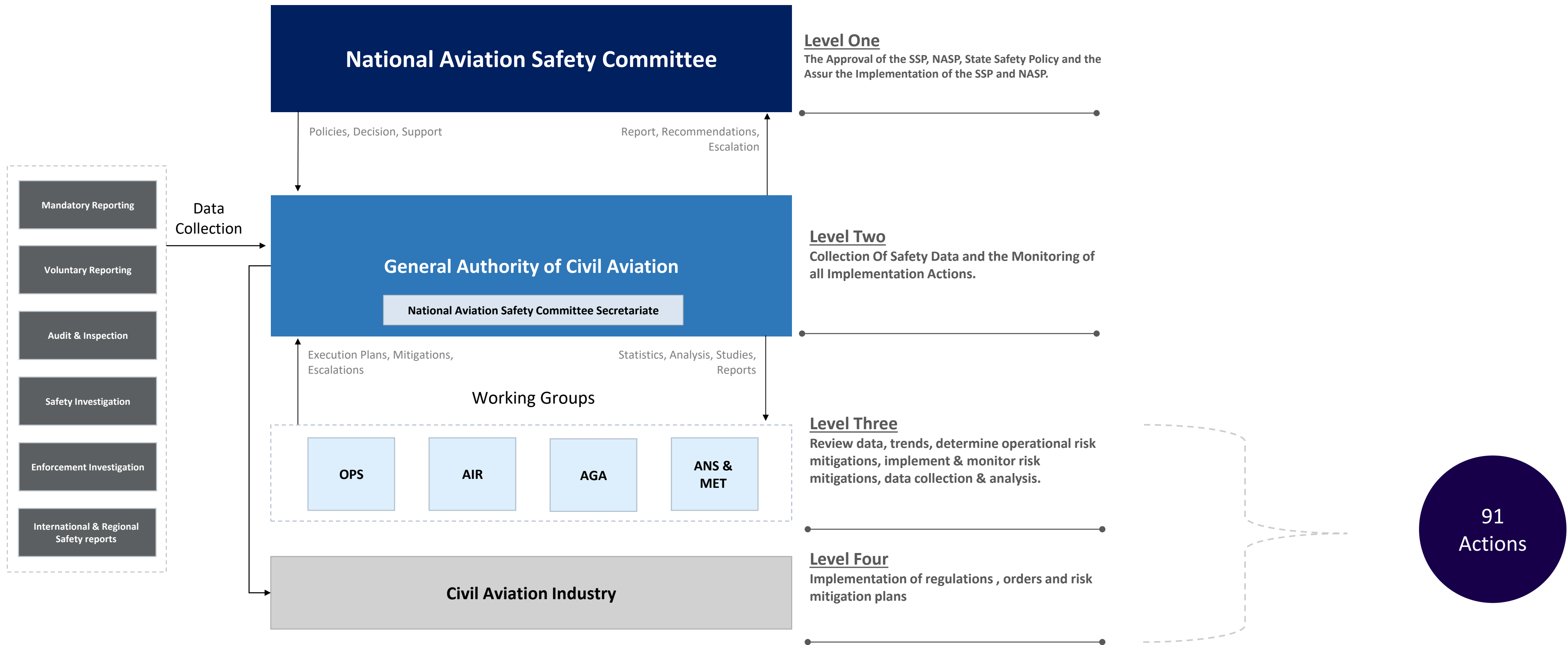
