



Tristan-Emmanuel Landry (BA Joint Honours [Political Science and History], McGill University, 1997; M.Sc. [Public administration and Public policy], London School of Economics, 2001) is currently serving as Head of the PS752 Task Force at Global Affairs Canada in Ottawa.

Mr. Landry joined the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT) in May 2001 and has served abroad in San Francisco (2005-07), Washington D.C. (2007-09), Kabul (2011-12), Port-au-Prince (2013-15), and recently as Counsellor and Head of the Political Section at the Embassy of Canada in Paris, France (2016-20).

In Ottawa, Mr. Landry served in a number of positions within the North American Branch and the Communications Bureau, including as Director of Media Relations for the Department of Foreign Affairs. As a communications specialist, he was seconded to support a few initiatives, including with Beyond the Border Working Group (BBWG) at Industry Canada and with the Summit Management Office (SMO) to organize the media program of the 2010 G8/G20 Summits in Toronto/Muskoka. Mr. Landry also served as Director for Consular Policy and Programs (2015-16), where he managed numerous consular and emergency crisis on behalf of the Department.

Before joining the Government of Canada, Mr. Landry worked for the Legislative Assembly of Ontario and the Institute for Research in Public Policy (IRPP), a Montreal-based think tank.
