ENAC: protection of the passenger and the protection of the rights of those affected by the plane accident



specific professional psychosocial assistance, involving "third parties" (eq. associations of victims' families, non-profit associations, volunteers, companies and associations with proven experience in dealing with the families of the victims)

training course on disaster recovery management
